



School Craft



There are different templates for a handprint craft. You have daddy or grandfather. You also have the option of typing in name and year. If older children are doing this craft, they can write their own name and year.

Supplies needed:

- White card stock
- Assorted color paint (Let child pick color they want to use).
- Paint brush
- Black marker
- · Googly eye
- Glue dot



Directions:

- Choose what template you would like to use for each child. If there is more than one child from a family, have them each do a different template.
- Type in the child's name and the year. If older children are doing this, you can print up and let children write their own date and year. Type in the blue boxes. They will not show up when you print.
- Have paint and paint brush ready. Ask child what color paint they would like to use and paint their hand. For Hands Down template you will be painting both hands, for Hooked on Daddy you will be painting only one hand.
- Place painted hand on template and let dry.
- For Hands Down nothing else is needed except for older children to write name and year. Hooked on Daddy, when dry using a glue dot attach eye and make lips on fish.




