# Father's Day Toolbox Craft



Supplies needed:

- White card stock or assorted color card stock
- Color crayons or markers
- Scissors
- Glue

You have the option of printing templates on white card stock and have children color. You can also print up on assorted color card stock and have children color out.

Directions:

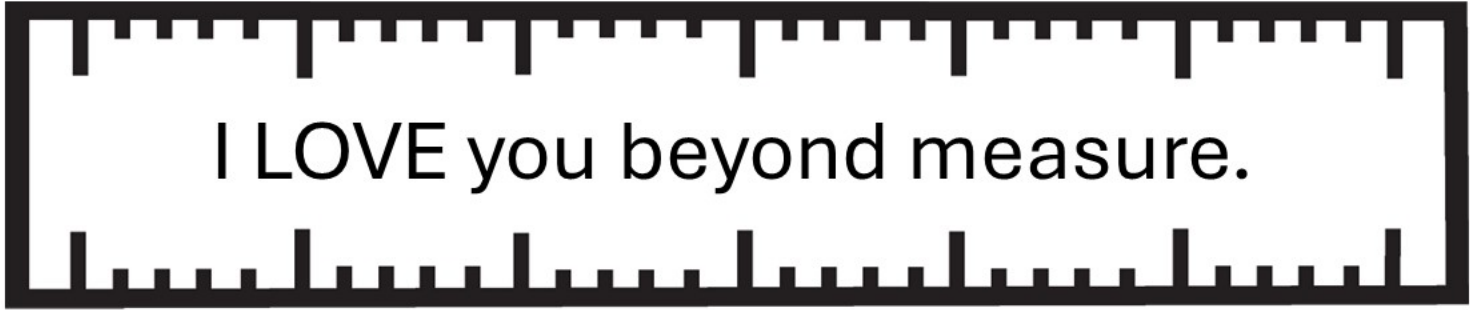
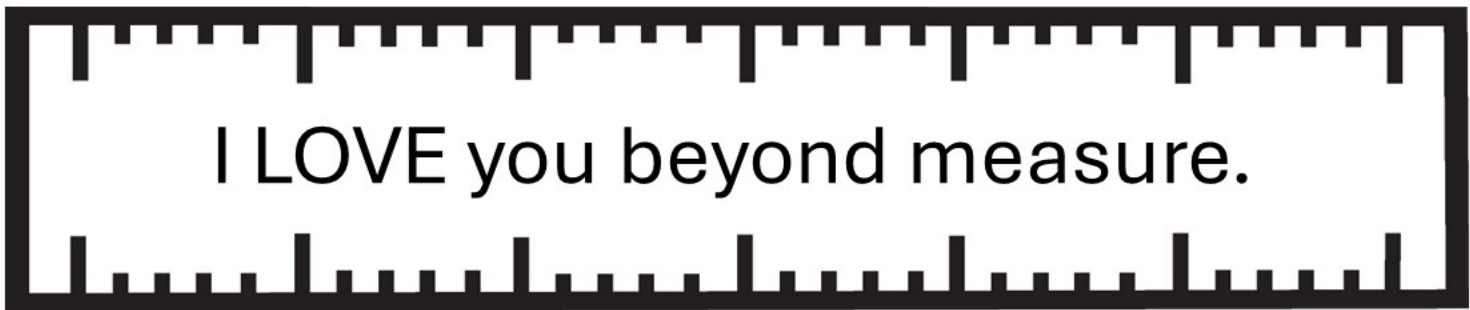
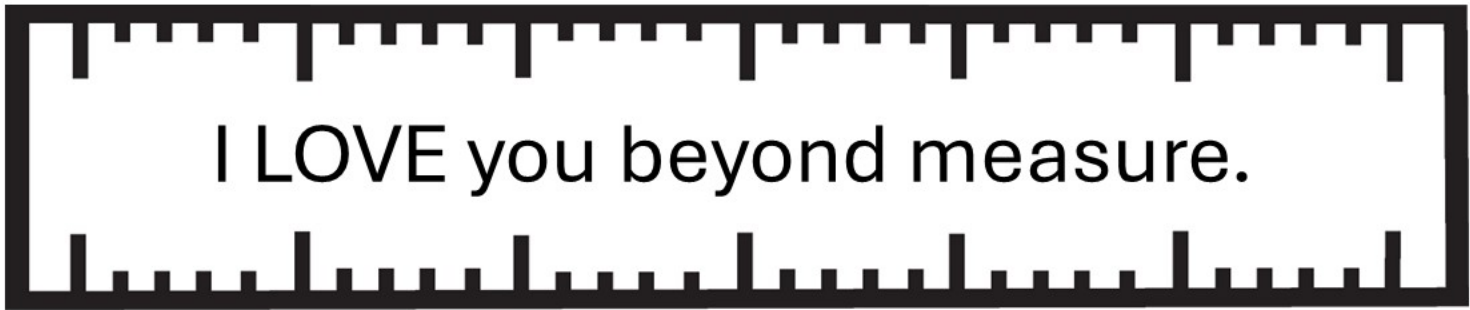
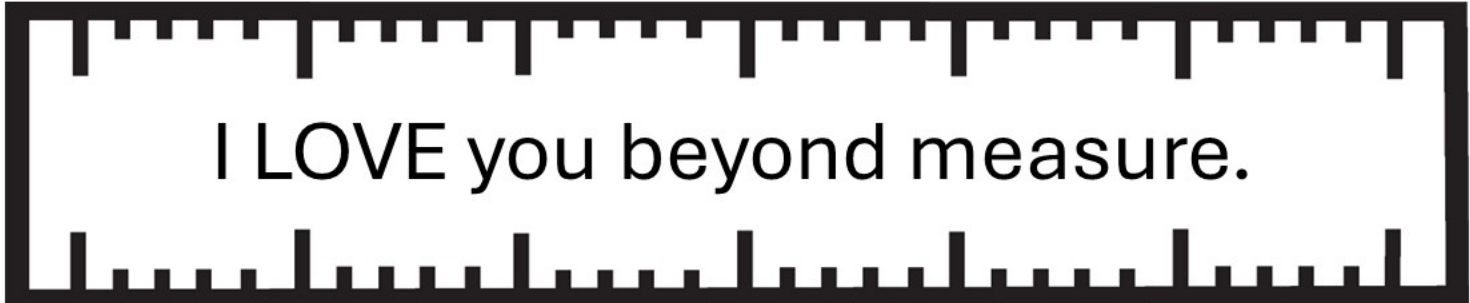
1. Print up sheets onto white card stock and color. For younger children type in their name in the blue box. When printing up the back of the toolbox, pick the saying that fits with each child. Dad, papa, grandpa, etc.
2. If using color card stock have children cut out.



1. You can use tools with sayings or use the white template tools and write what children would like to say on them.
3. After children have everything cut out, have them glue the front to the back, making sure that the wording is both on the front and back of the toolbox. (Glue just on the outer edge of the toolbox so the children can slide the tools in the toolbox).
4. Have children write their name under love and slide in the tools into the toolbox.



If you are printing up on white card stock and having children color, print up the templates for tools on white card stock and cut so each child gets one tool to color.







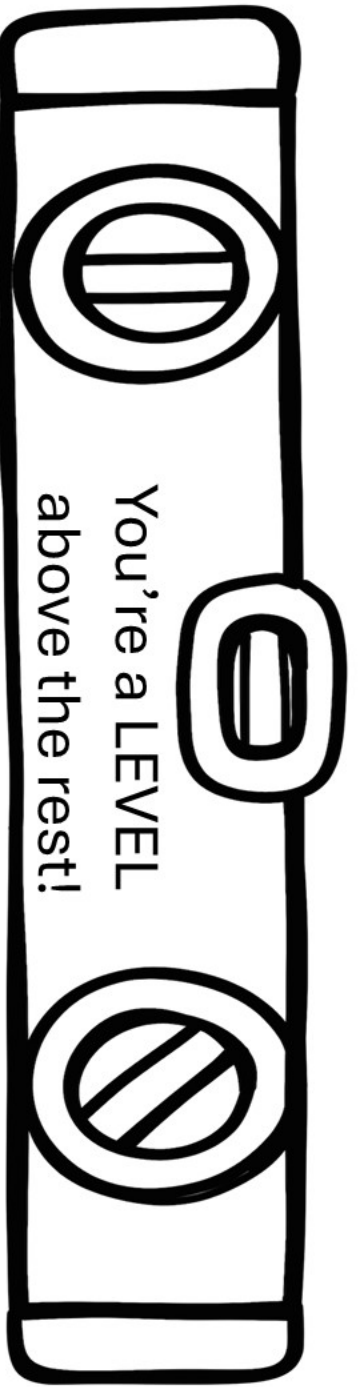
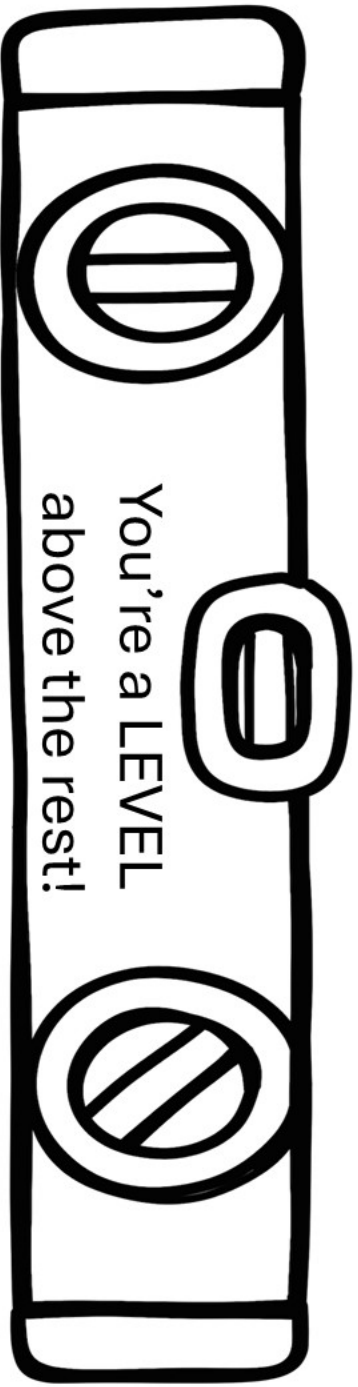
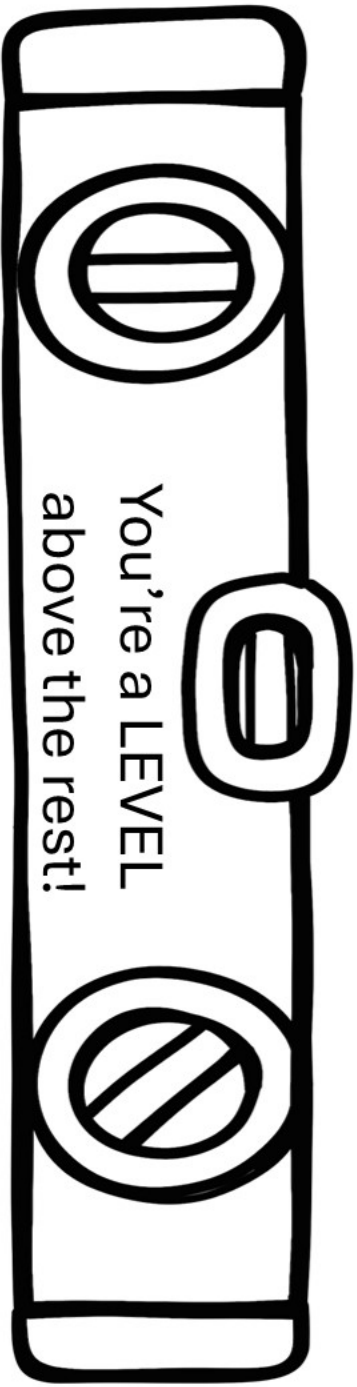
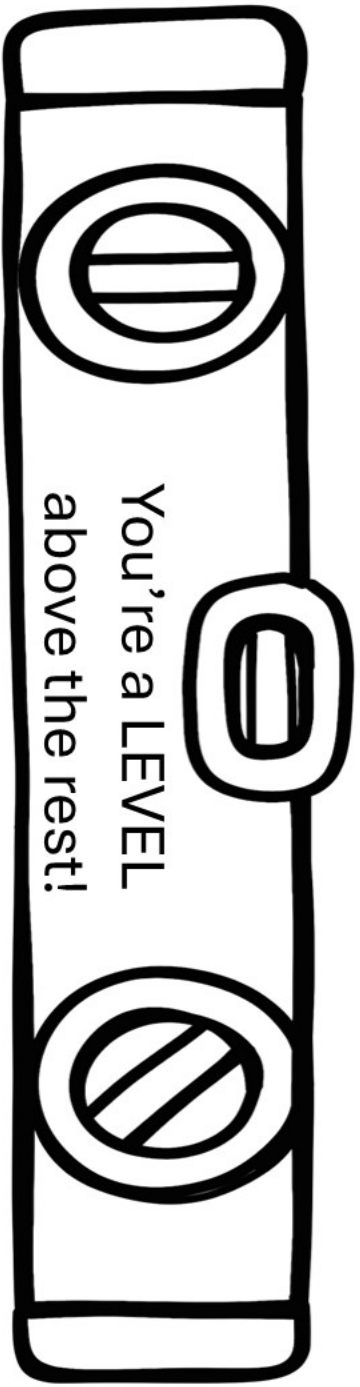


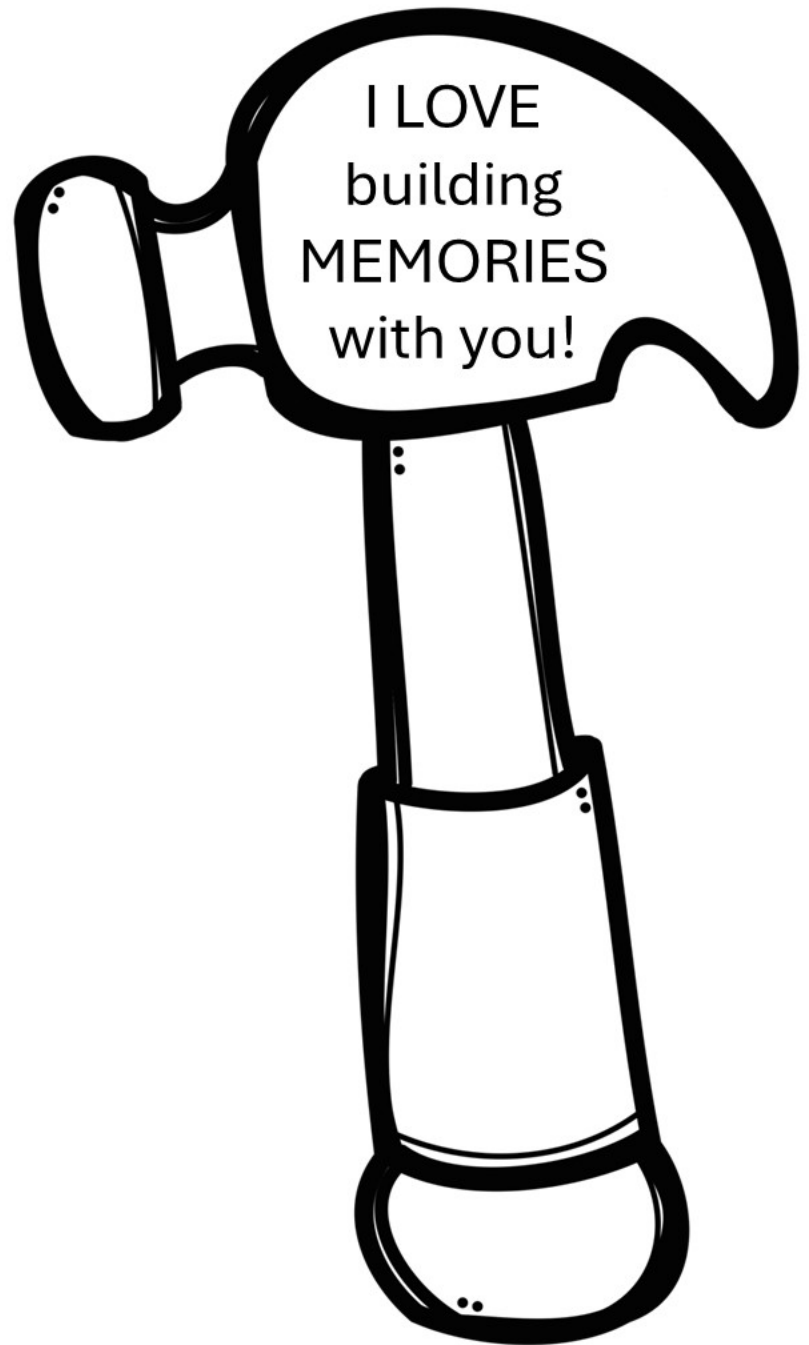
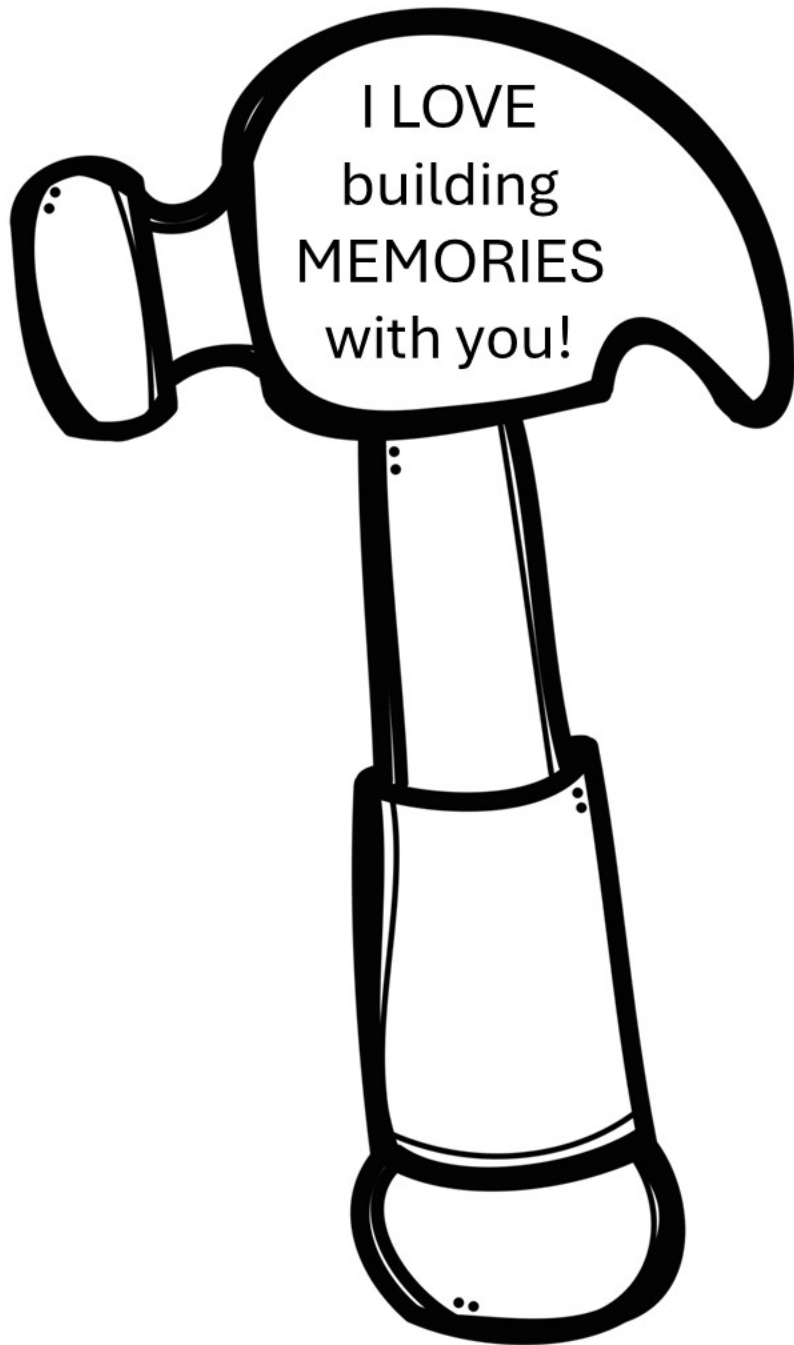




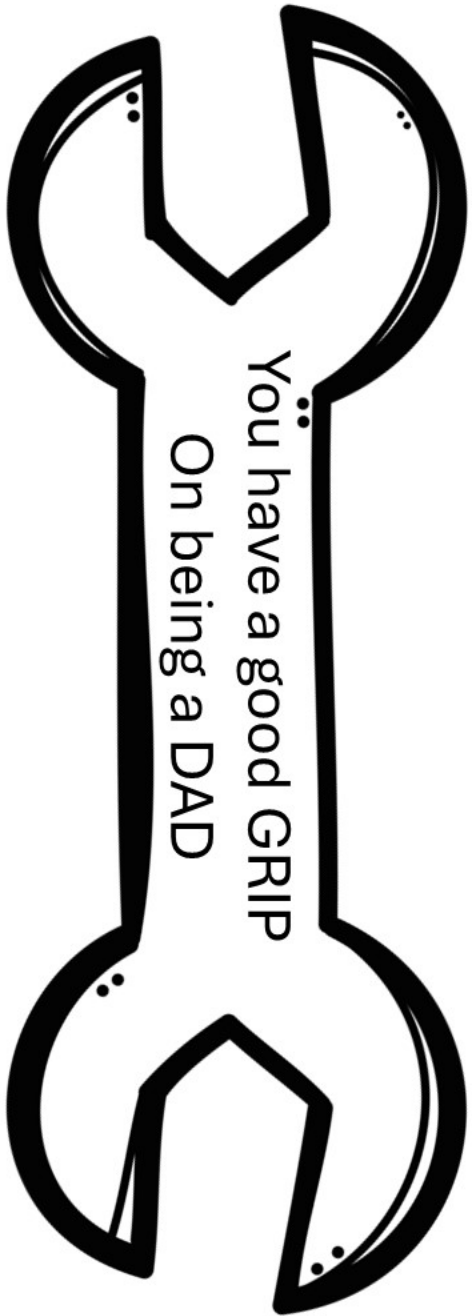
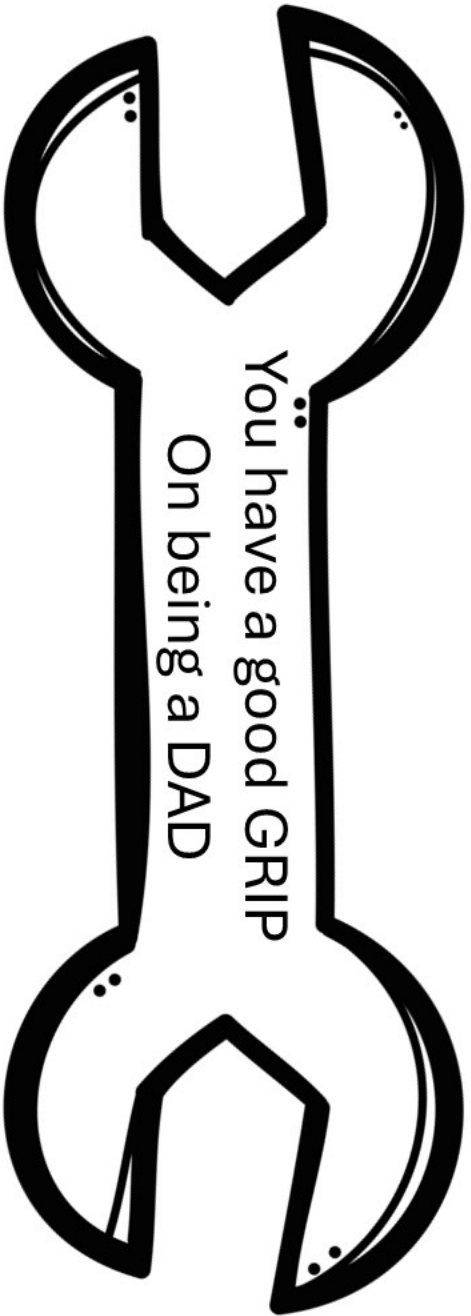
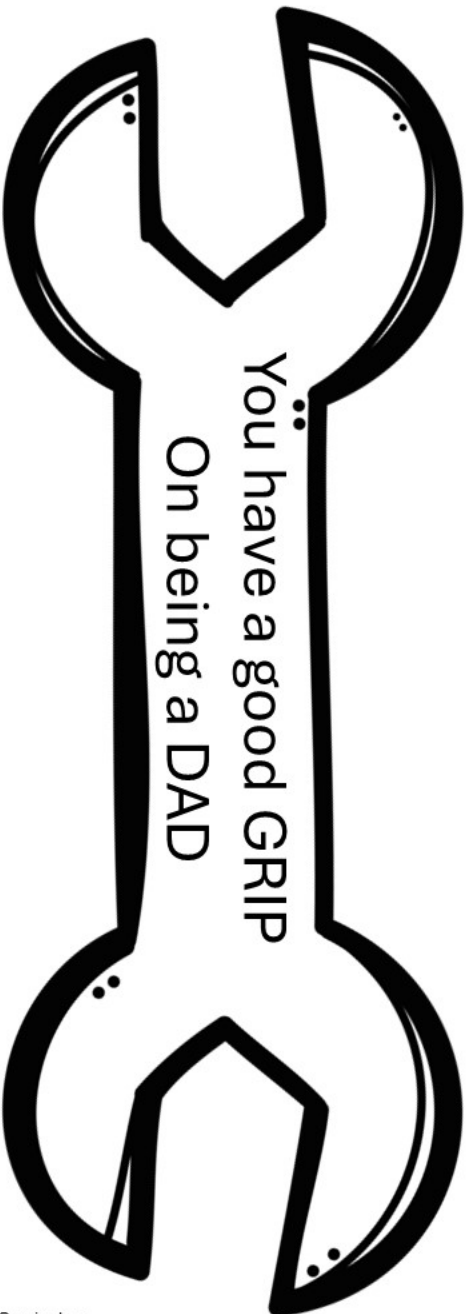


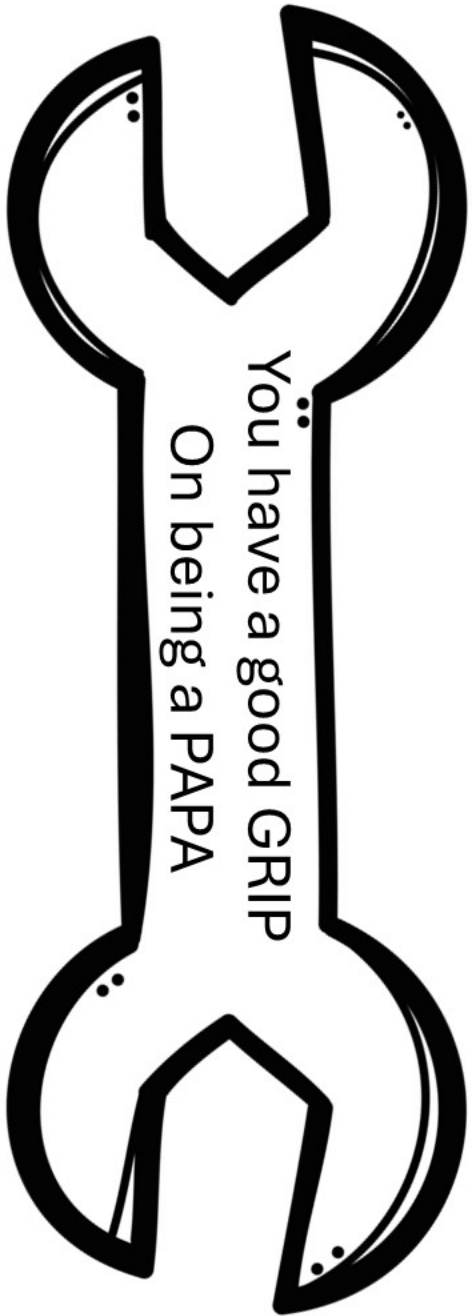
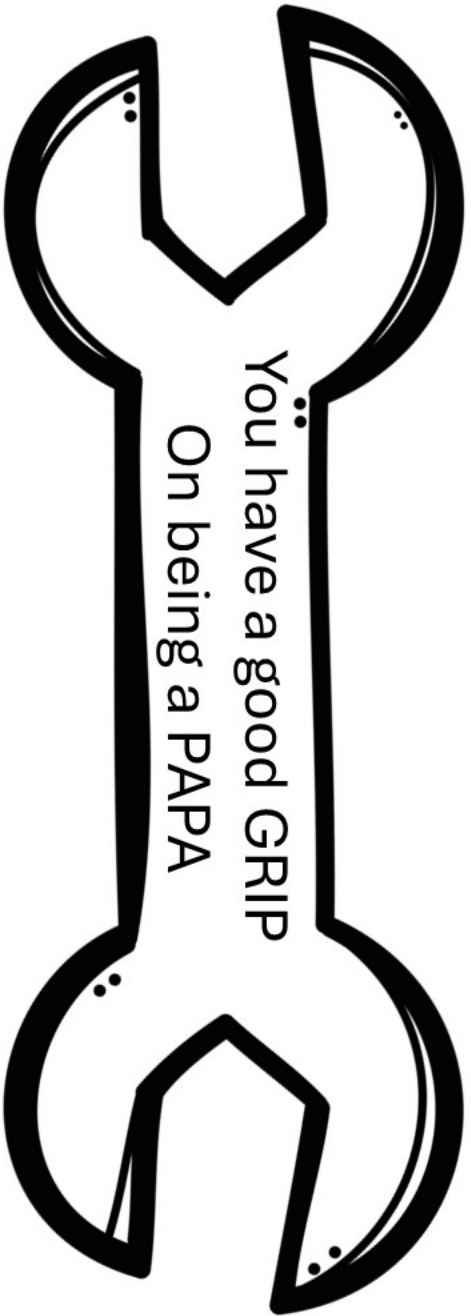
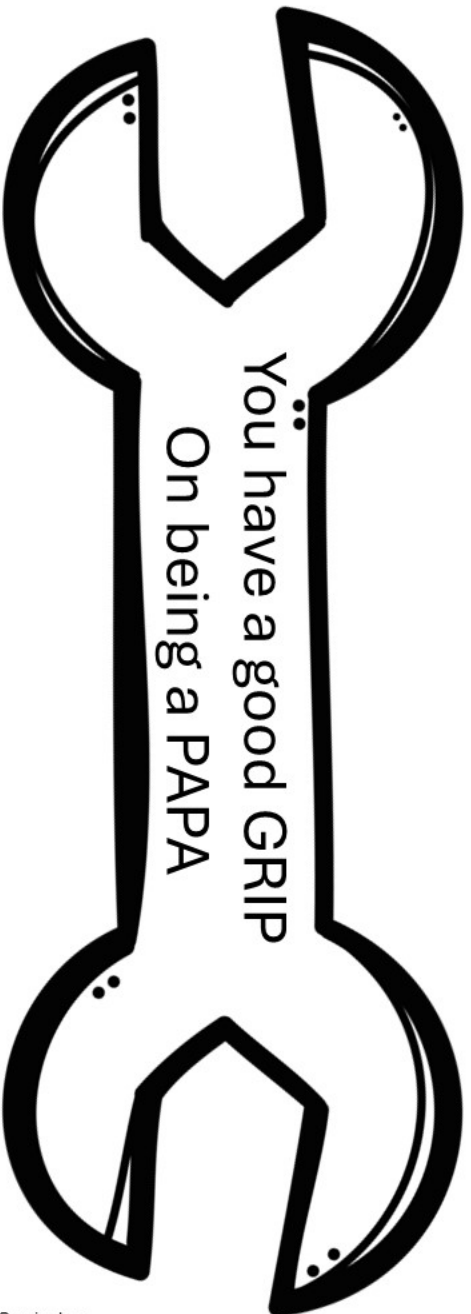


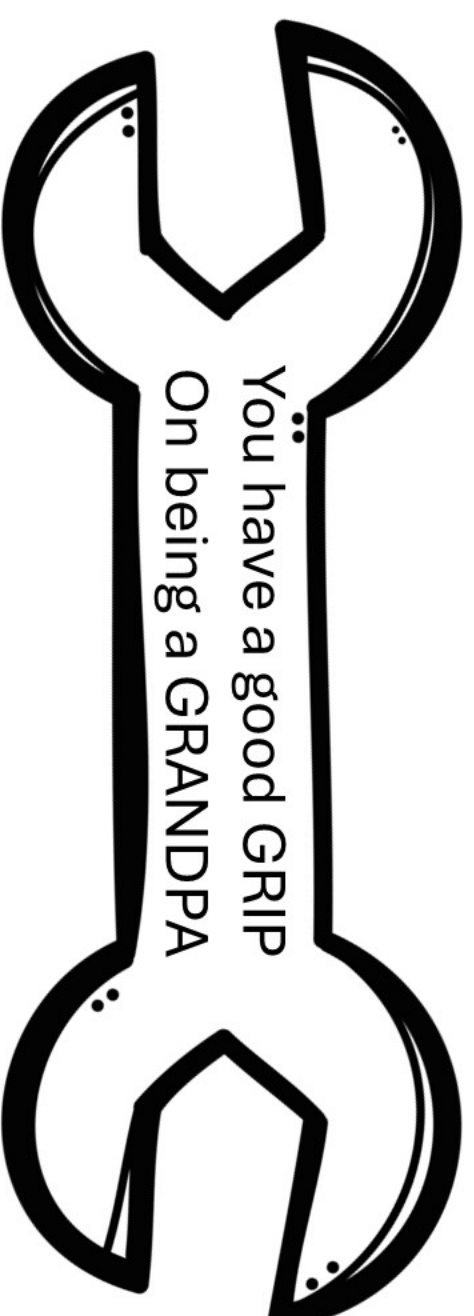
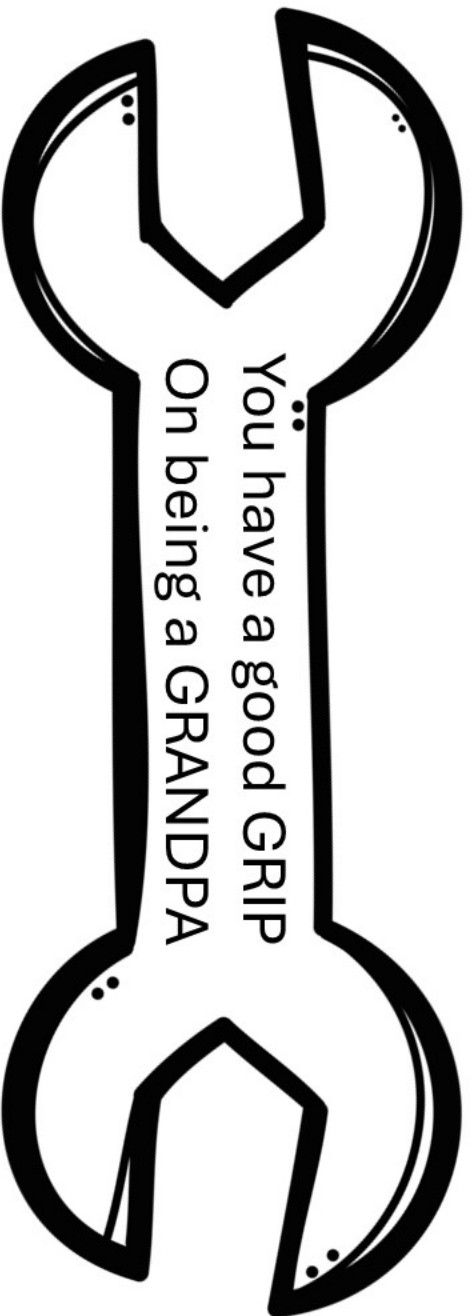
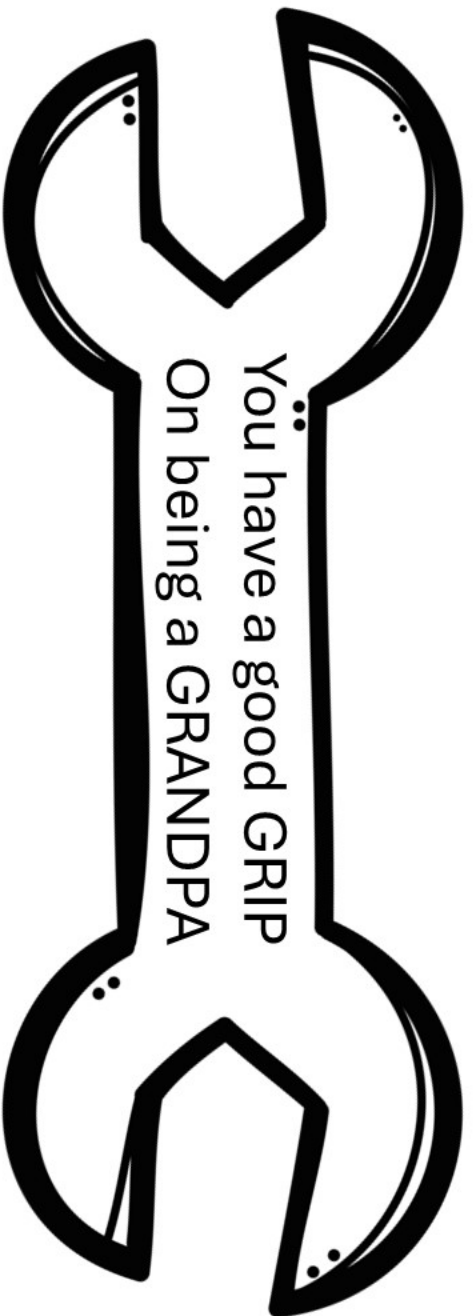


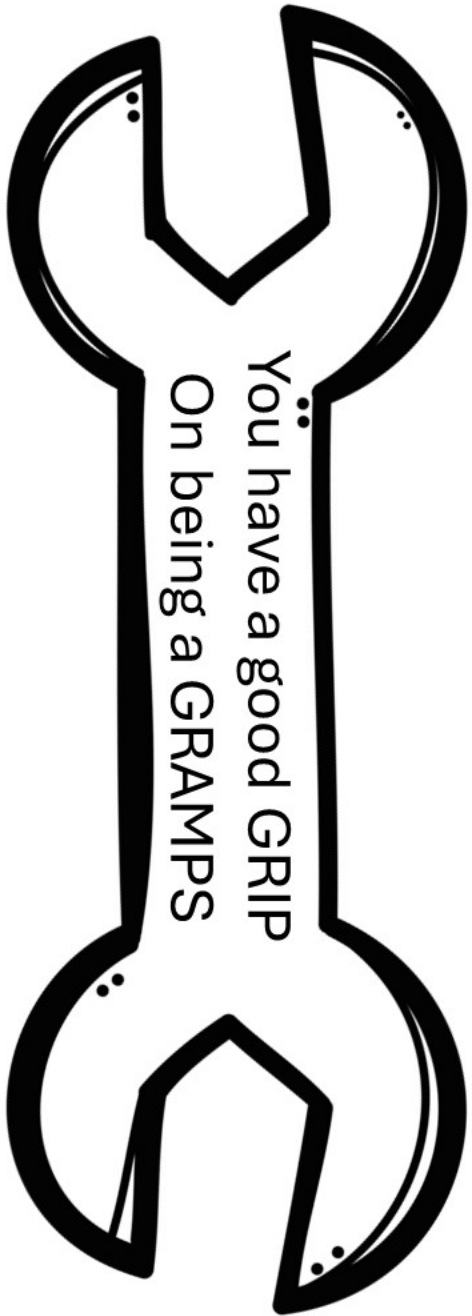
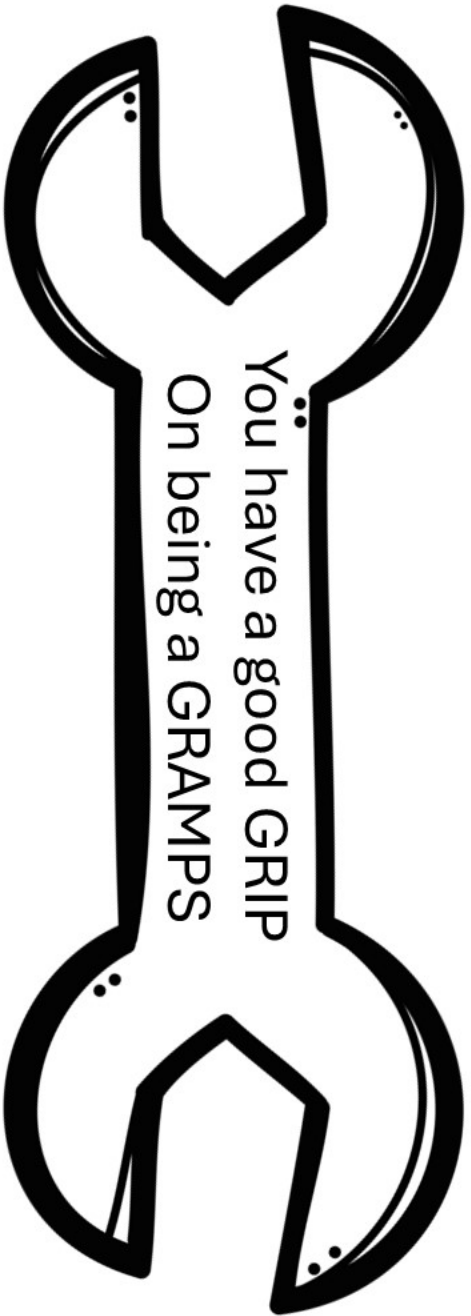
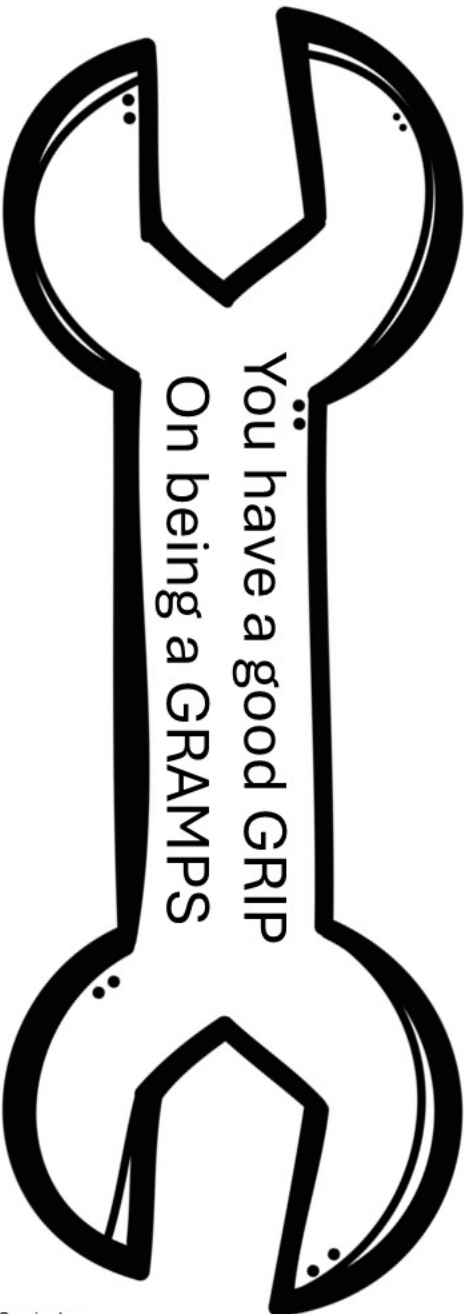


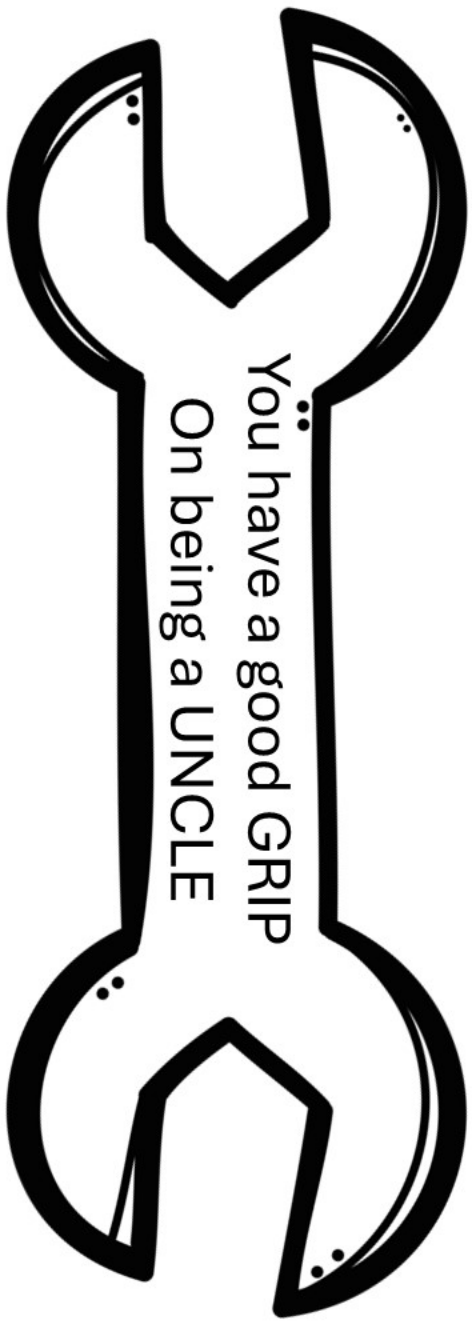
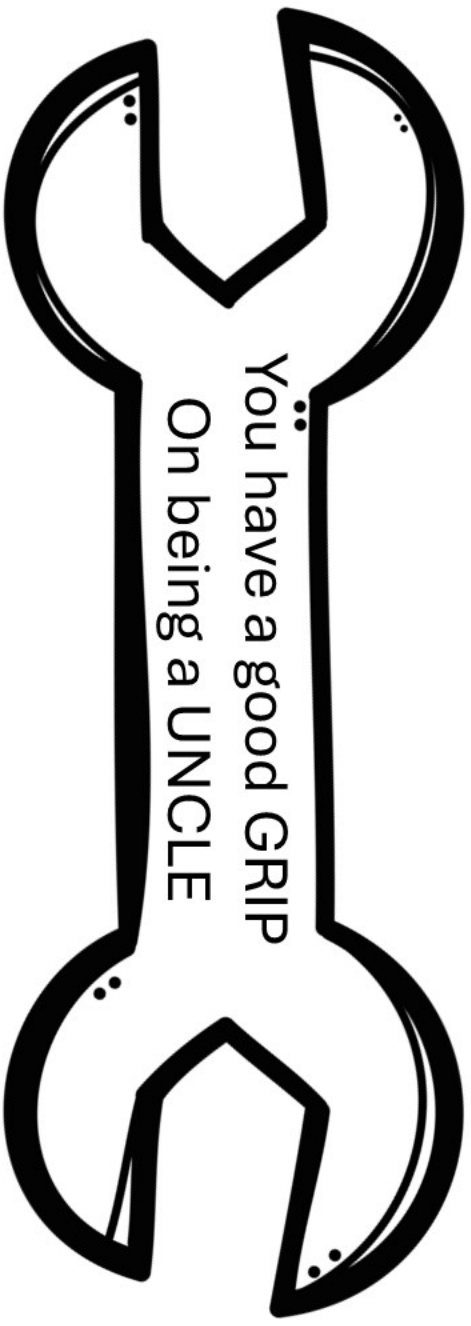
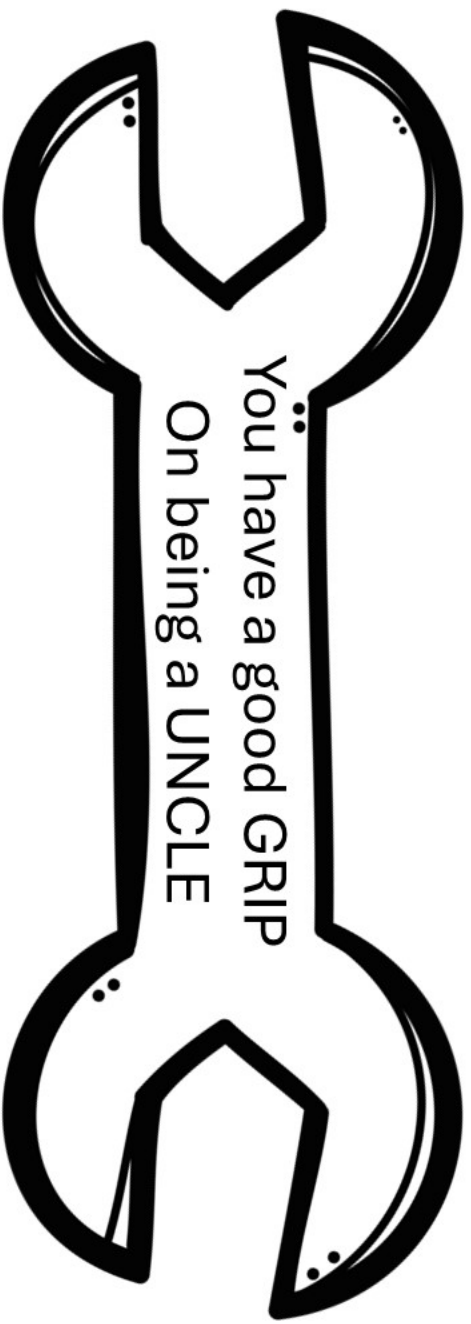


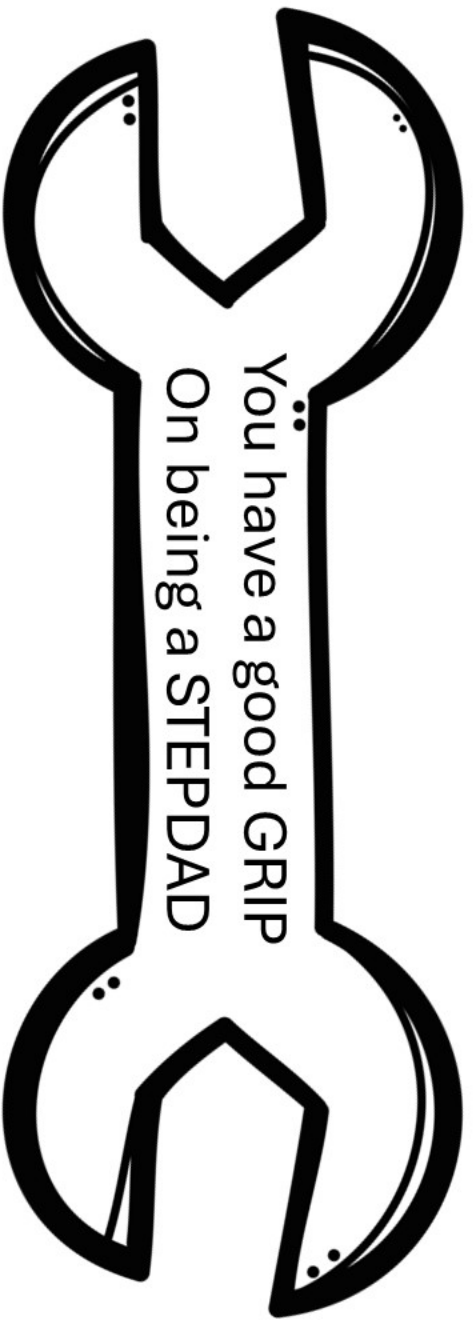




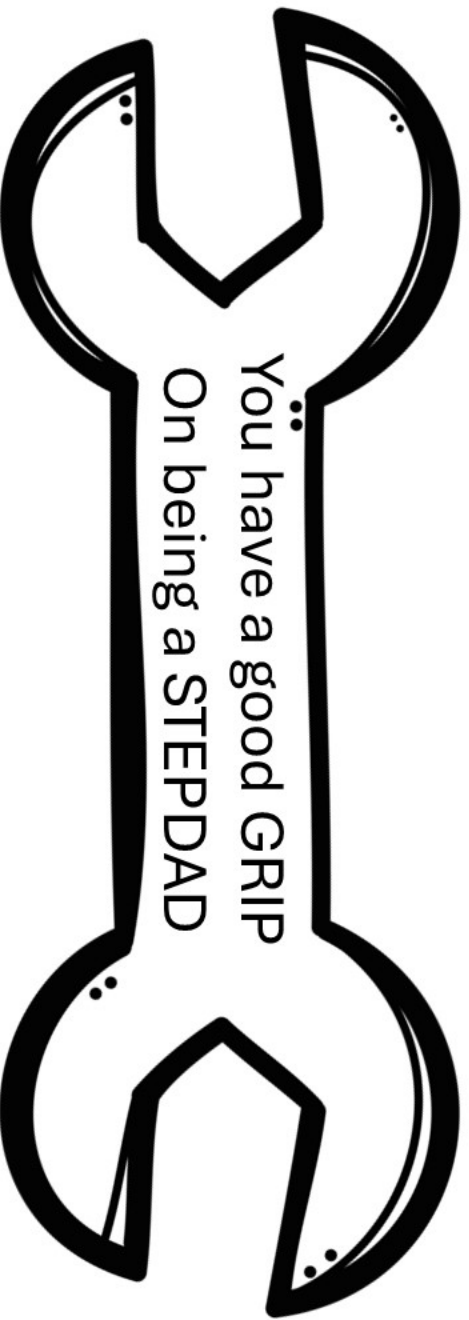




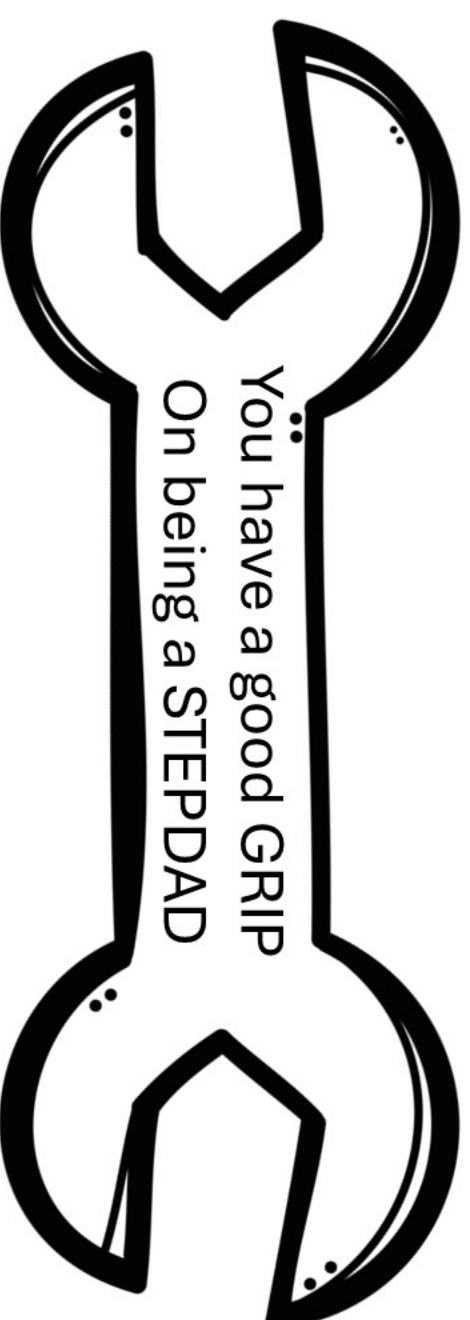




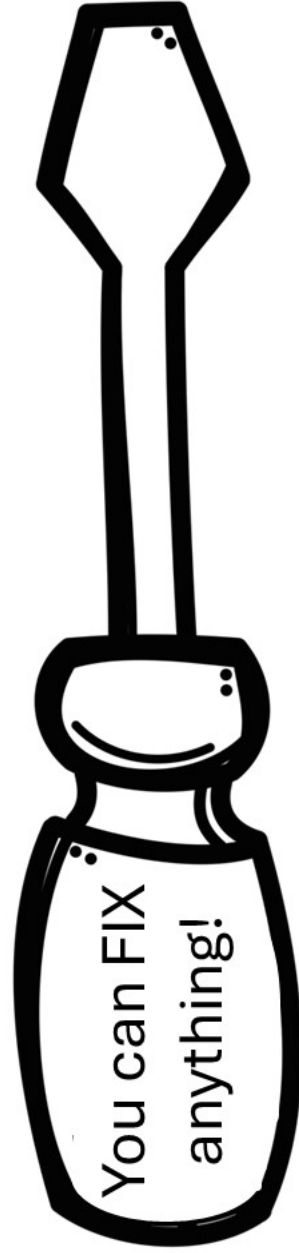
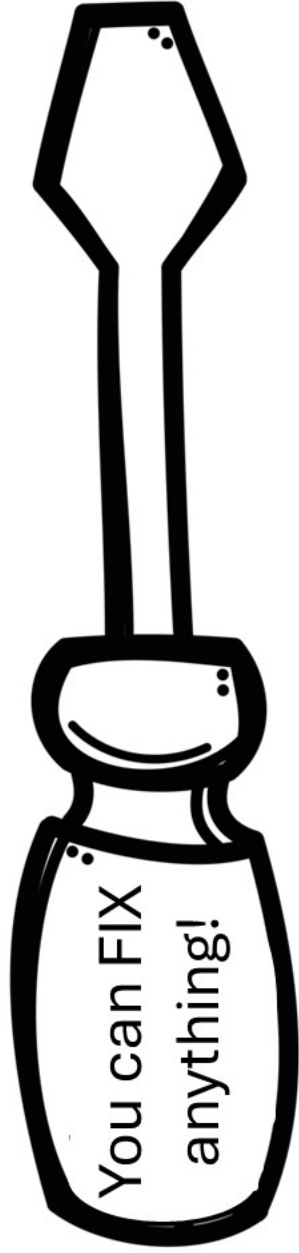
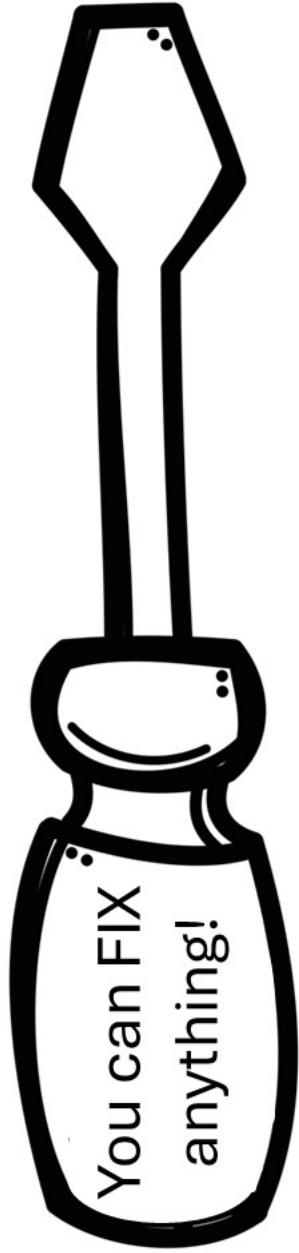
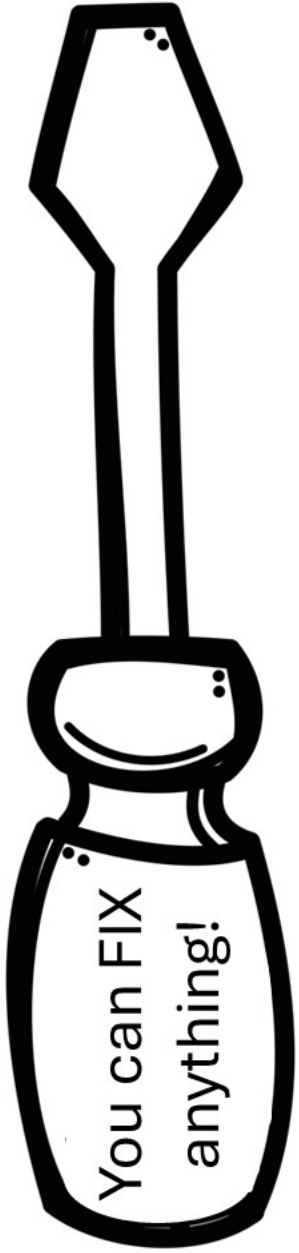
