

# Footprint Picture

Choose the color or B & W picture. Print up on white card stock. If using the B & W sheet, let the child color.

Using an ink pad or paint, have the child place their foot onto the sheet to the right of the poem, leaving a footprint.

Take a piece of construction paper and cut out a frame.

Tip: Have the child place their foot onto a blank piece of white cardstock. When it dries, cut the footprint out. Tape it onto a color piece of cardstock or construction paper and trim leaving a border. Attach onto the sheet with poem.
