

Penguin



Supplies needed:

- penguin template
- orange card stock
- white card stock
- black card stock
- white crayon
- glue
- wiggly eyes
- scissors

Directions:

- Print up the body of the penguin on white card stock. Cut out and use this oval as a template to cut out the body of the penguin on black card stock.
- Print out the 2nd smaller oval on white card stock and use this as a template to cut out the white part of the body of the penguin on white card stock. (You could print all the templates for this part of the penguin's body on white card stock, and cut out.)



- Print up the beak and feet sheets on orange card stock.
- Cut out all pieces ahead of time, or separate the pieces and have children cut out.
- Using a piece of black card stock, trace the children's hands with white crayon. Trace their hands with fingers together. Have children cut out. These will be the penguins wings.
- Have children place glue on the white body part, and place on the black body of the penguin.
- Glue on beak, feet, eyes and wings (Children's hands).
- When finished you will have an adorable penguin made with the hands of the children.



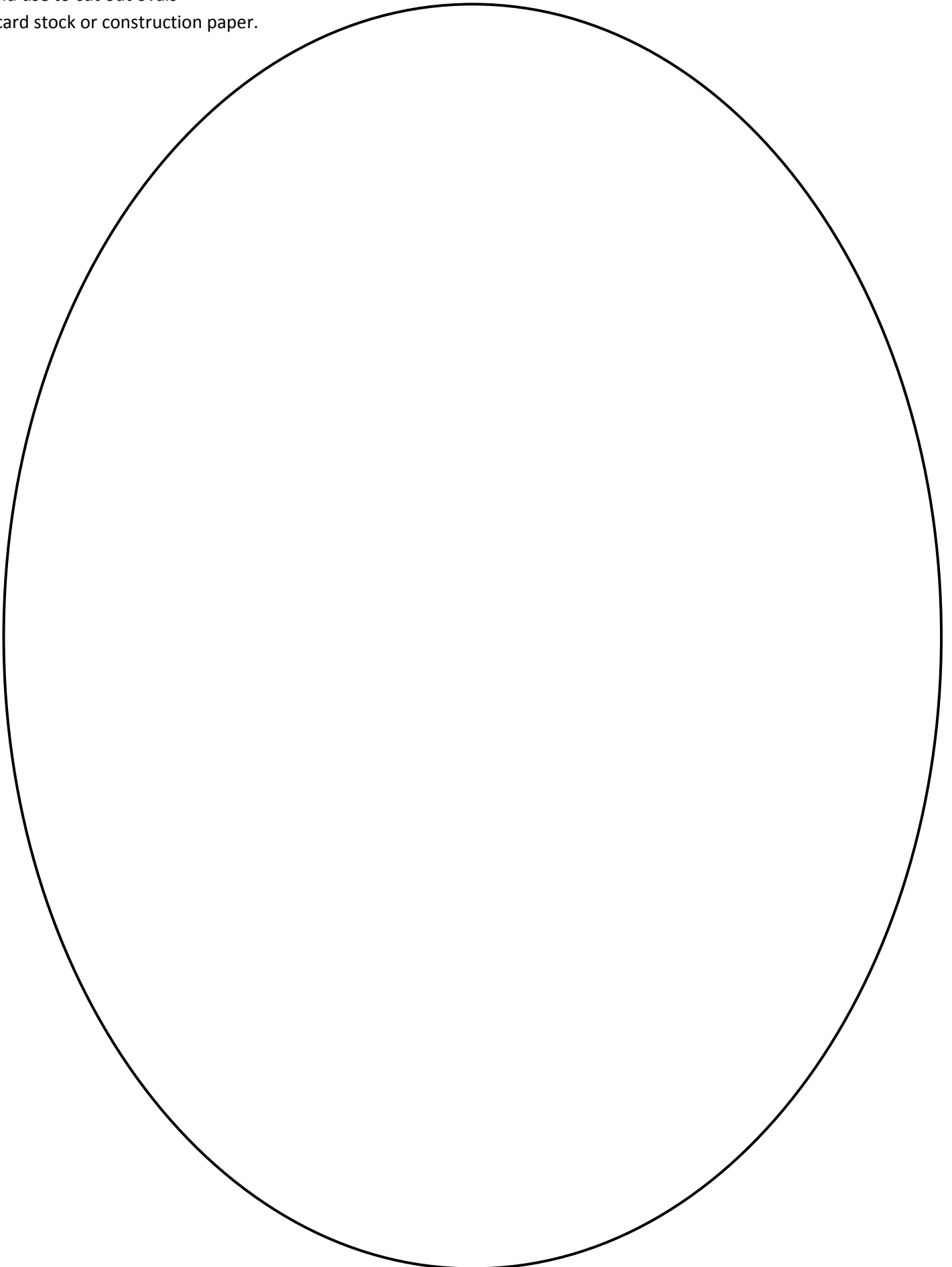
Hang up these adorable penguins for all to enjoy during your Arctic Animals theme.

Cut out and use to cut out ovals

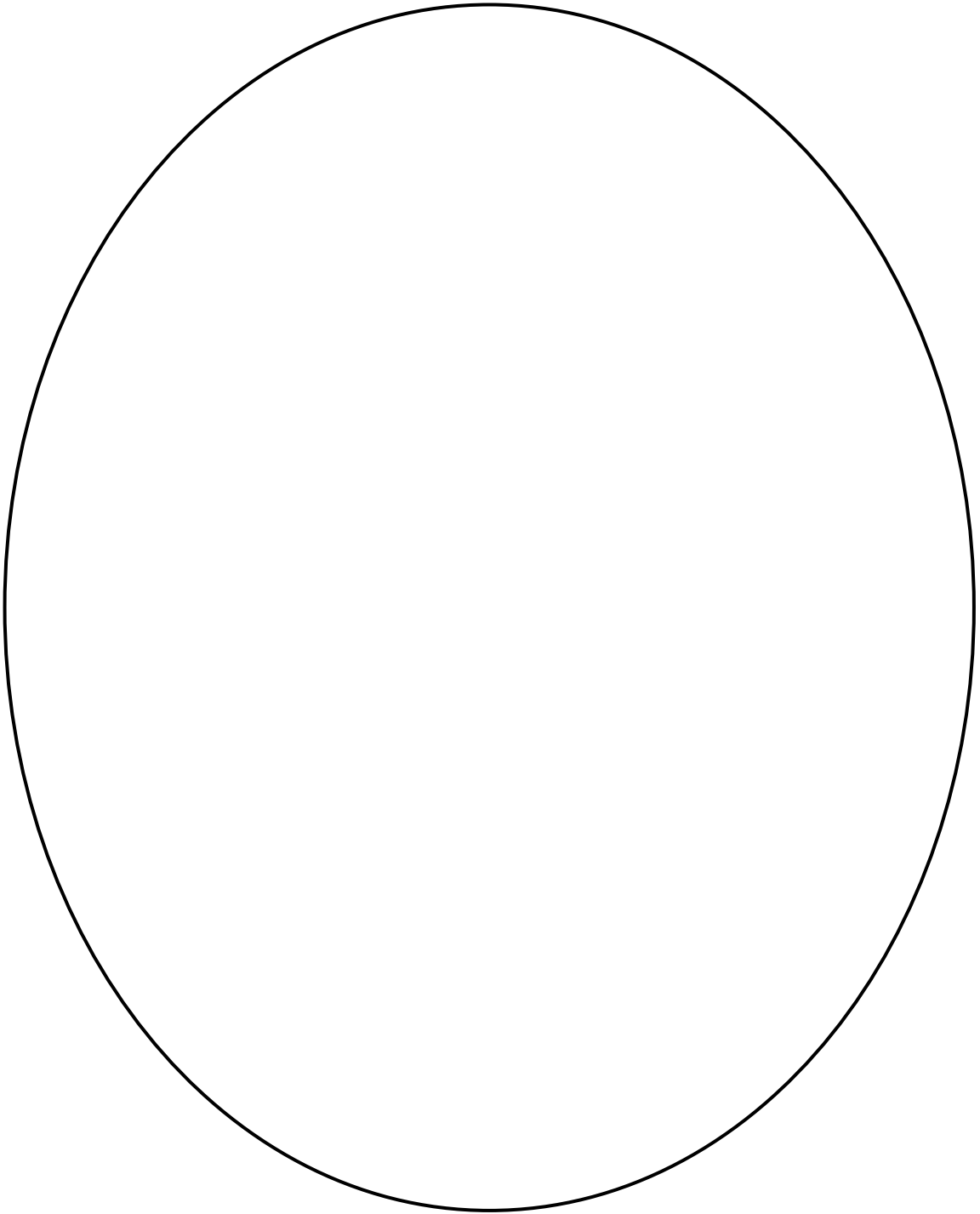
on black card stock or construction paper.

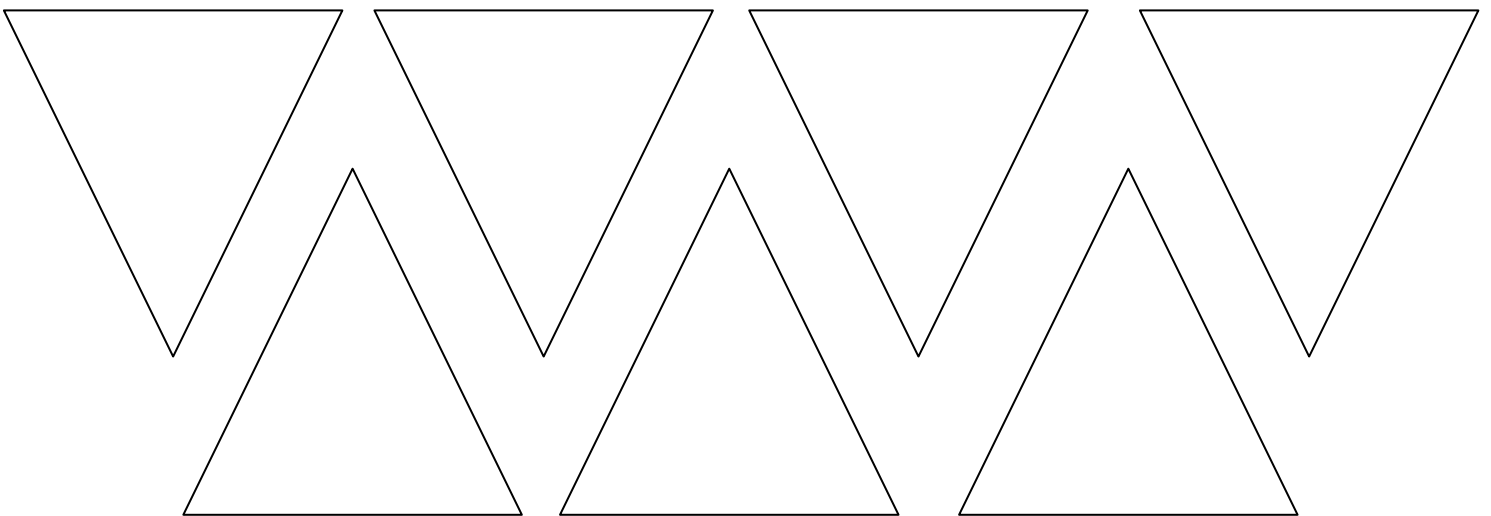
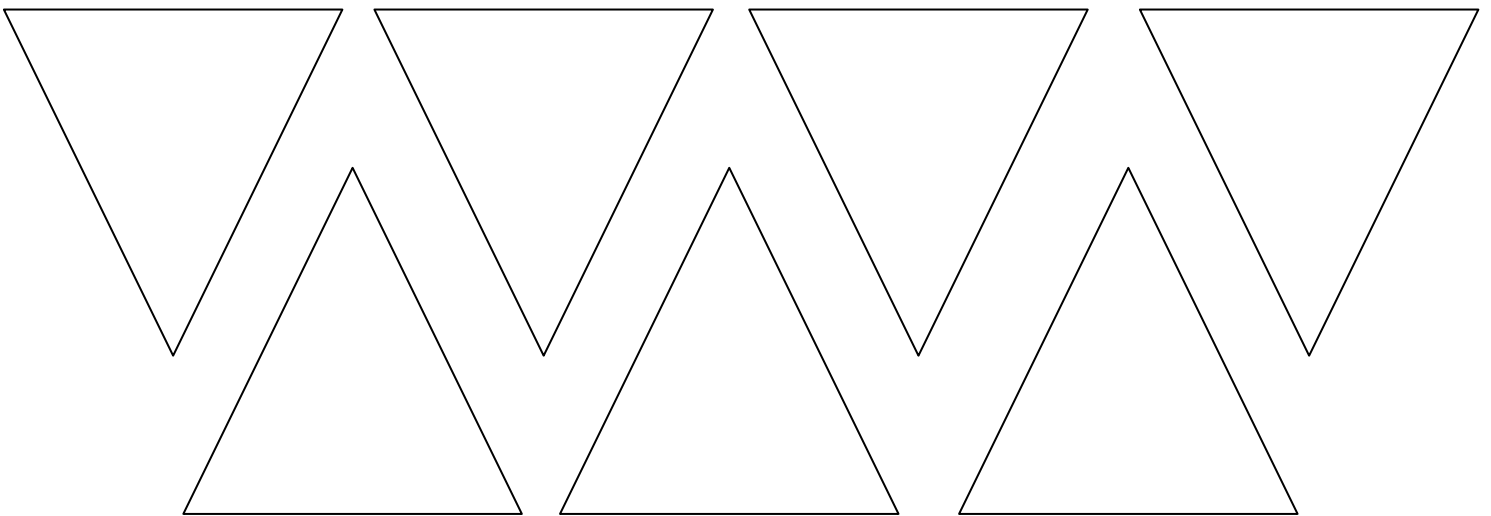
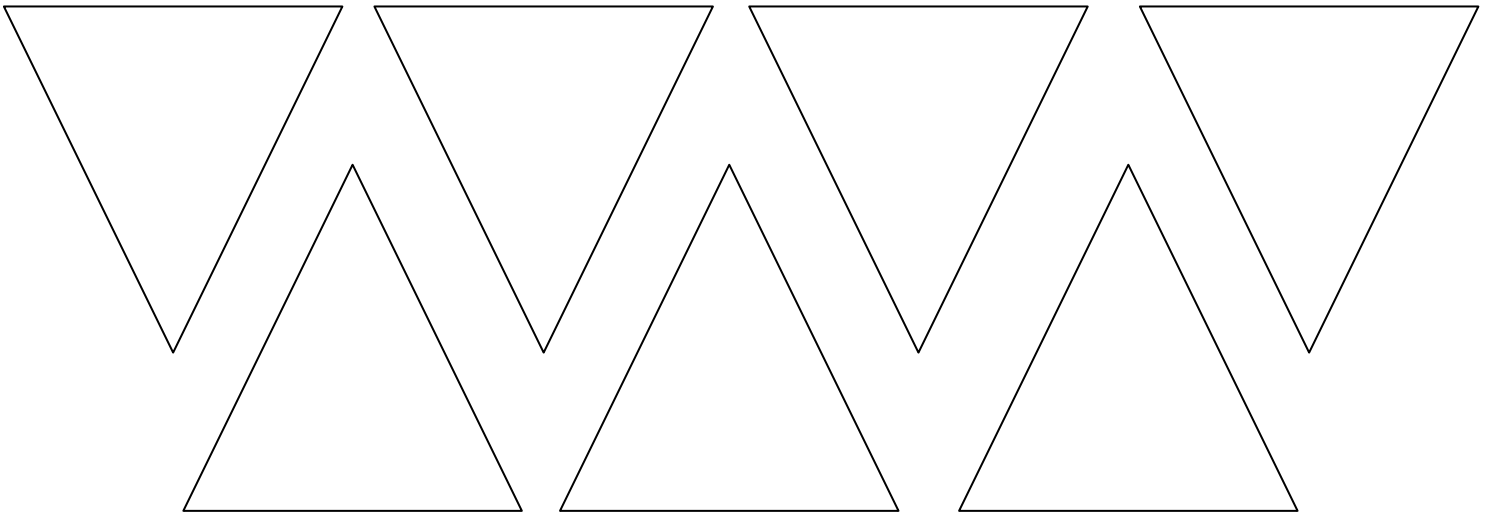
Use oval as template. Print up on white card stock.
