To save on ink - change your print quality on your printer to fast.

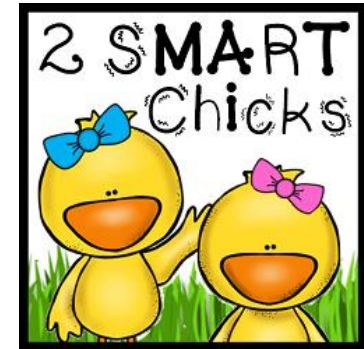
To do:

Supplies needed:

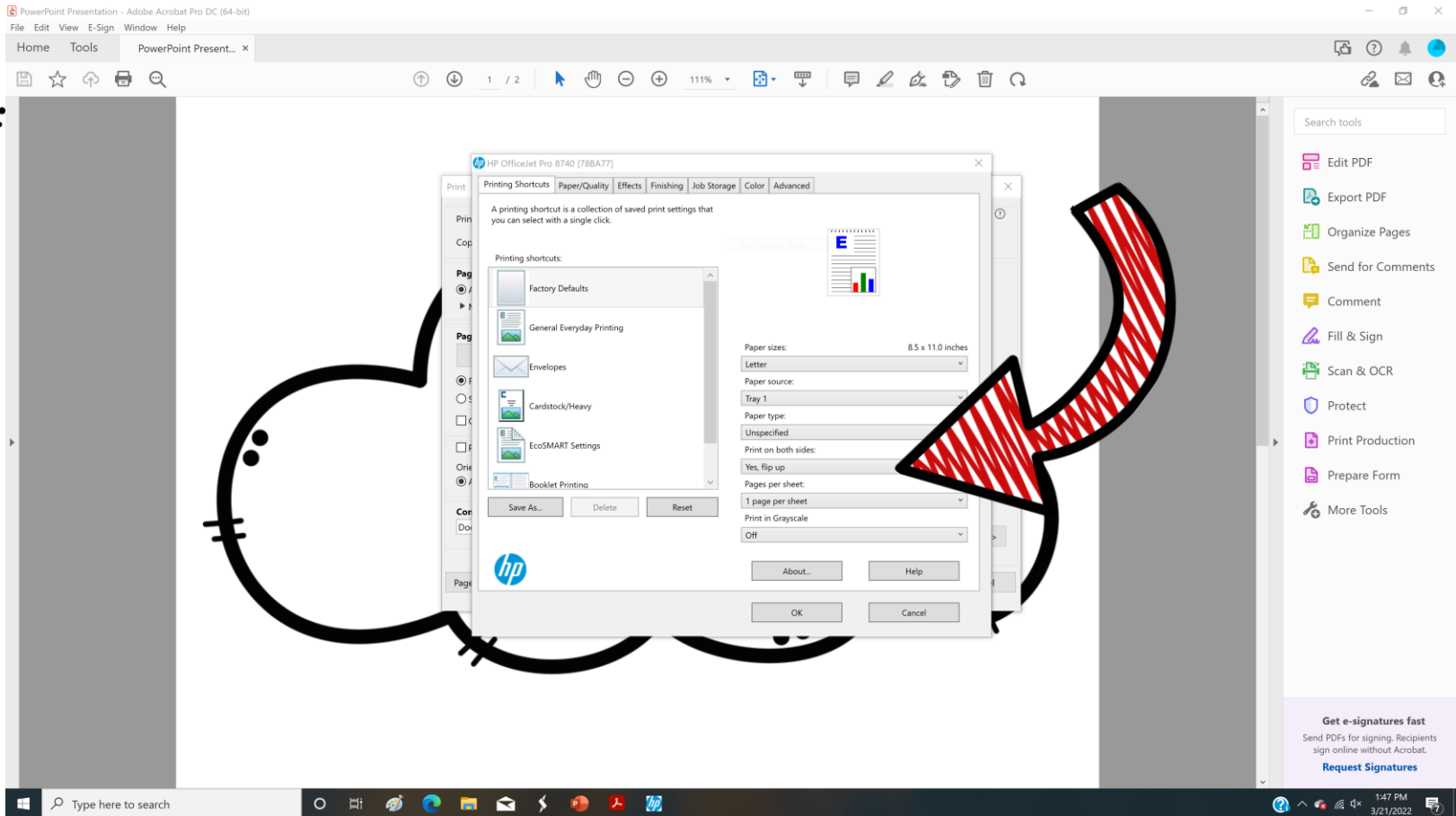
- White card stock
- Red, orange, yellow, green, blue, dark purple and violet card stock.
- Glue
- Cotton balls
- $\frac{3}{4}$ " color circles



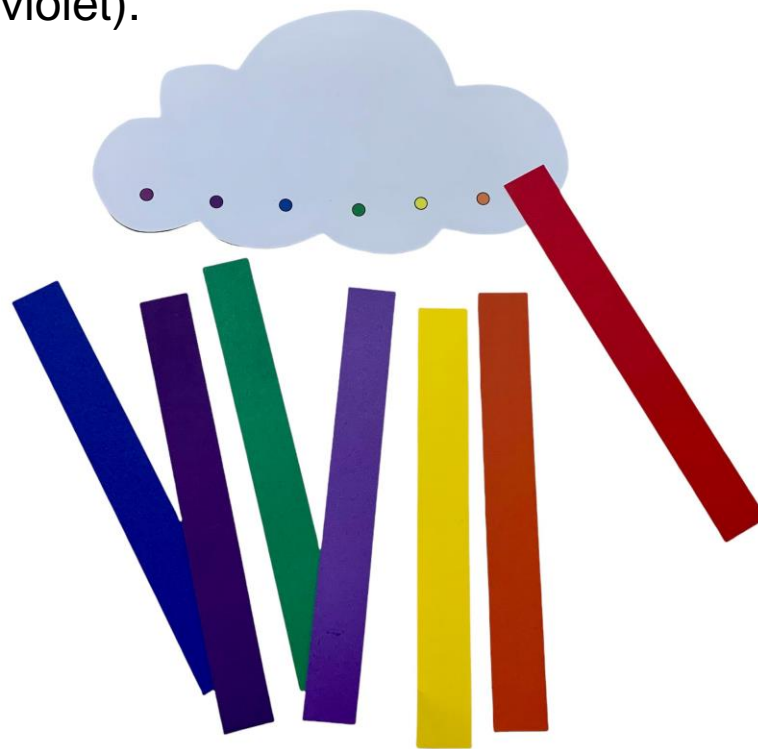
Directions:

- You will print the cloud and the following sheet back-to-back. You will click on print – print on both sides and click on Yes, flip up. You can see a sample picture of printer setting on the following page. You will print the cloud on white card stock.

Sample of printer setting



- Take the other card stock and cut it on the 8 ½ length, 1-inch strips.
- Each child will get a total of 7 strips, one of each color. (Red, orange, yellow, green, blue, dark purple and violet).

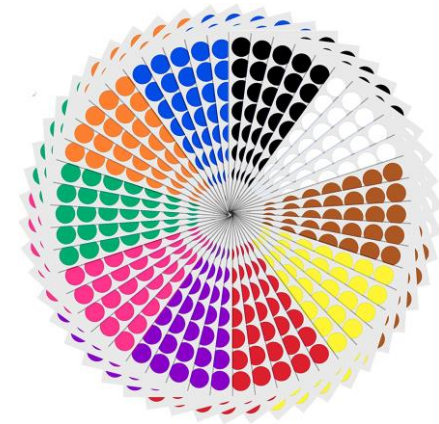


- When putting together the rainbows, have children flip their cloud over so that the color dots are showing.
- Children will put glue on the violet dot and attach the violet paper.
- Continue with each dot, attaching the correct paper strip until all dots are covered.



- Have children flip back over their cloud and glue cotton balls on the cloud. Have children pull the cotton balls apart to make them less dense.

- A finishing touch is having children put color stickers on each strip of their rainbow. Red stickers on red, orange stickers on orange, etc.
