

Butterfly Footprints



Supplies needed:

- White ceramic tile (Get tiles according to size of the child's foot. Sample shows 6" x 6".)
- Acrylic paint - assorted colors
- Paint brushes
- Elmer's painter paint markers - black and other colors. (To color in butterfly body and do circles on antenna's.)
- Smart sliders (for the back of the tiles. Can be purchased from Menards or other store).

Using a paper plate put assorted colors on the plate, getting ready to paint each child's foot.

Paint one foot at a time and place on the tile, the foot prints will be placed on the tiles opposite sides to create the butterfly wings.

Let the footprints dry.

Have children draw the butterfly's face and body. (You can do this for the younger children).

Make the circles for the antenna's and color the body of the butterfly in.

Write the child's name and date using the Elmer's painters marker. (Black)

When completely dry, turn over and place 4 smart sliders on the back for cushioning.



Butterfly Flower Pot



Supplies needed:

- Ceramic flower pot (get pots according to the size of the child's foot).
- Acrylic paint - assorted colors
- Paint brushes
- Elmer's painter paint markers - black and other colors. (To paint color in butterfly body and do circles on antenna's)

Using a paper plate put assorted colors on the plate, getting ready to paint each child's foot.

Paint one foot at a time and place on the flower pot. The foot prints will be placed on the flower pots opposite sides to create the butterfly wings.

Let the footprints dry.

Have children draw the butterflies face and body. (You can do this for the younger children).

Make the circles for the antenna's and color the body of the butterfly in.

Write the child's name and date using the Elmer's painters marker. (Black).
