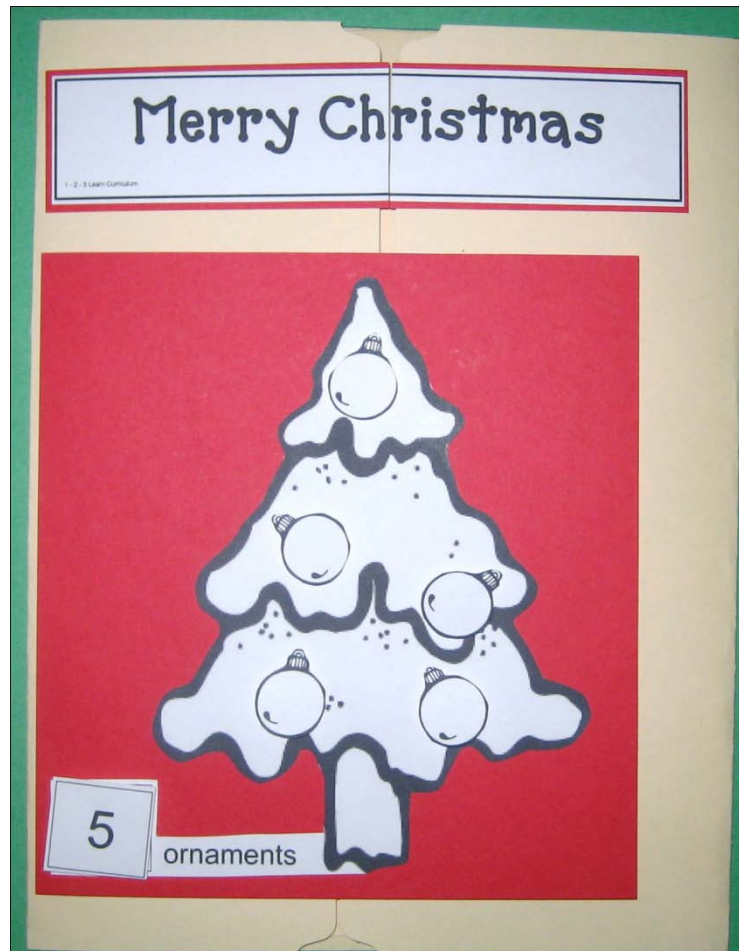
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Merry Christmas Lapbook


- Print up the cover sheet onto white card stock.
- Have children color and cut out.
- Add to a red piece of card stock and trim the red card stock. (See sample).
- Add to the front of the lapbook.
- Store the numbers and ornaments in an envelope inside the lapbook.
- Have children place a number in the square and place the correct number of ornaments on the tree.

(Idea: Place small pieces of velcro on the tree, ornaments and numbers. This way the items won't move when children are playing with their lapbook).



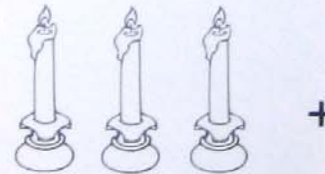
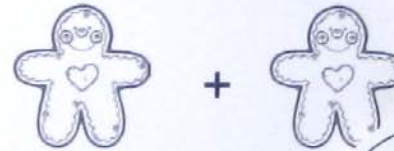
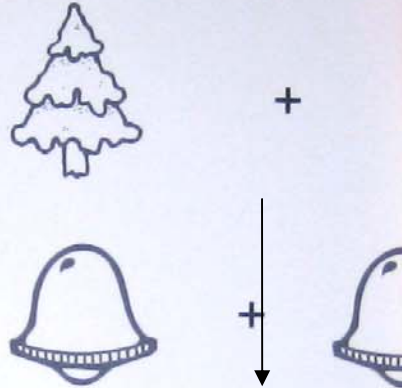

My Christmas Counting Book

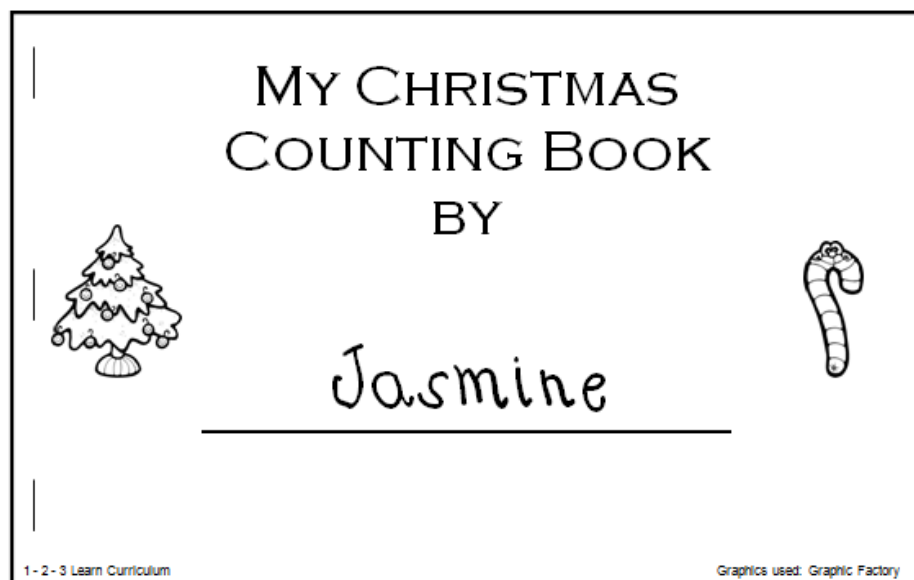
Option 1: Print up the counting sheets (1 set per child). Trim, place sheets in order and staple together to make a book. Let the children count and color.

Option 2: Print up sheets. Let children do 1 sheet per day. Let the children count – write the numbers and words. Color and cut out.

After all sheets are done, place the sheets in order and staple together.

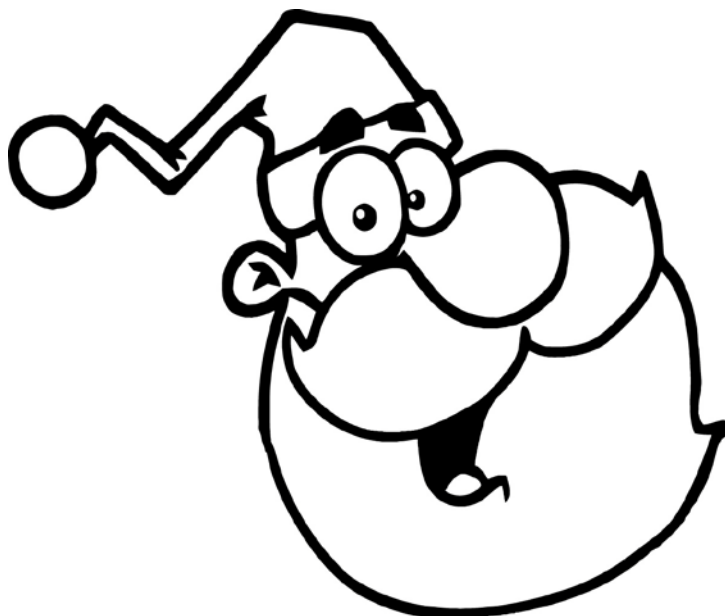
So pages don't get mixed up, place the child's name in the lower corner on the back of each page as they cut them out.

Books include number and words for older children to count and write number and practice writing the word on each page.

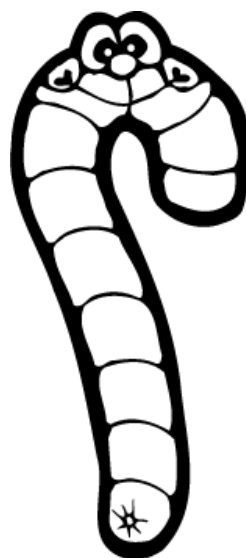

- Use cards in your writing center. Let children practice writing the words on a dry eraser board or paper.

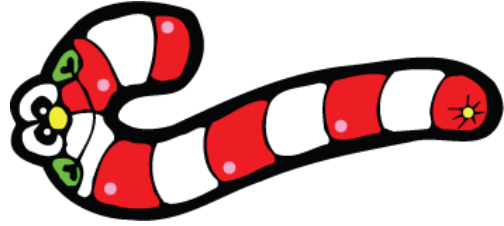

What I See at Christmas Time Book

- Follow directions to print book on the following sheet.
- On the back of the lapbook, using a piece of red card stock, attach to the bottom. (See picture). You will attach using double sided tape or glue. (Use tape or glue on the sides and bottom of the card stock. When attached, this will create a pocket to store book.

What I See at Christmas Time

Book comes in 2 formats

- With dotted words
- Without dotted words

Print first 2 sheets back to back. Fold in $\frac{1}{2}$.

Print up last 2 pages back to back. Fold in $\frac{1}{2}$ and place inside the cover.

Please note: Use the book format that works best with each child. Older children can practice writing the words without the dashes.

Staple if desired. (You will need a longer stapler in order to do this. Can be purchased at Office Max or other office supply store).
