# Fall Lapbook

- Print up the cover sheet onto white card stock.
- Have children color and cut out.
- Add fall label and picture to a piece of orange card stock and trim the orange card stock. (See picture below).
- Cut the fall label in half, and attach to both sides of the lapbook, so that when the lapbook is closed, the label connects.
- Add picture to the front of the lapbook.

## Fall Fun Numbers

- Print up the following sheet onto white card stock.
- Cut out the items.
- Attach the Fall Fun mat to the inside of the lapbook. (Look at pictures at the beginning of this file to see placement).
- On the back of the number cards place a small piece of velcro. (Using the soft side of the velcro).
- Attach a small piece of the rough side of the velcro to the soft piece of velcro, and place the number inside the number box. You will want to place just one piece of the rough velcro in the number box since you will only be using one number at a time).
- Do the fall pictures next. Small soft piece of velcro to the back of each fall picture and then attach a small piece of rough velcro. Place the fall picture inside the mat.
- Once you have all pictures placed where you want them, you can remove the pictures, and the rough part of the velcro will stay in place.

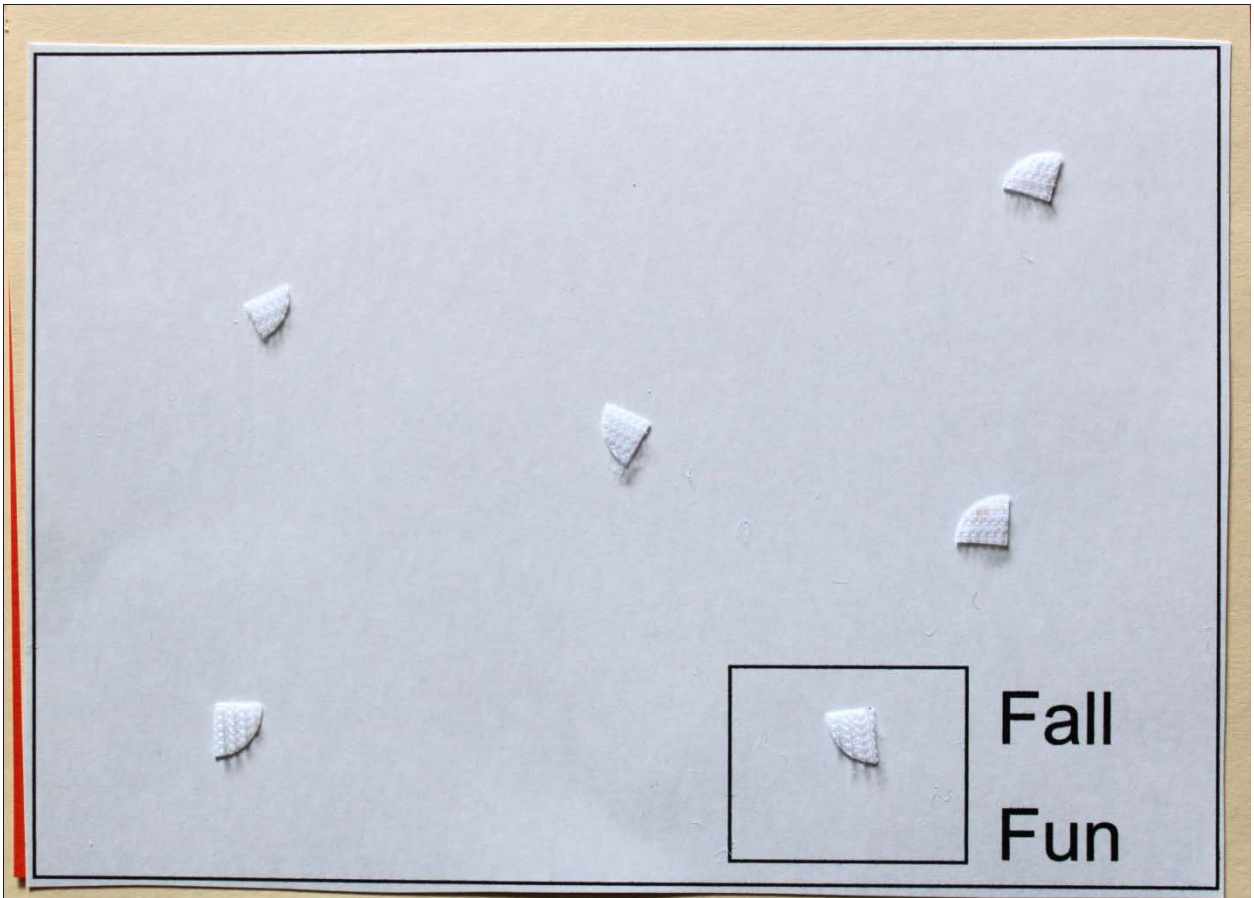


## Object of Fall Fun Numbers

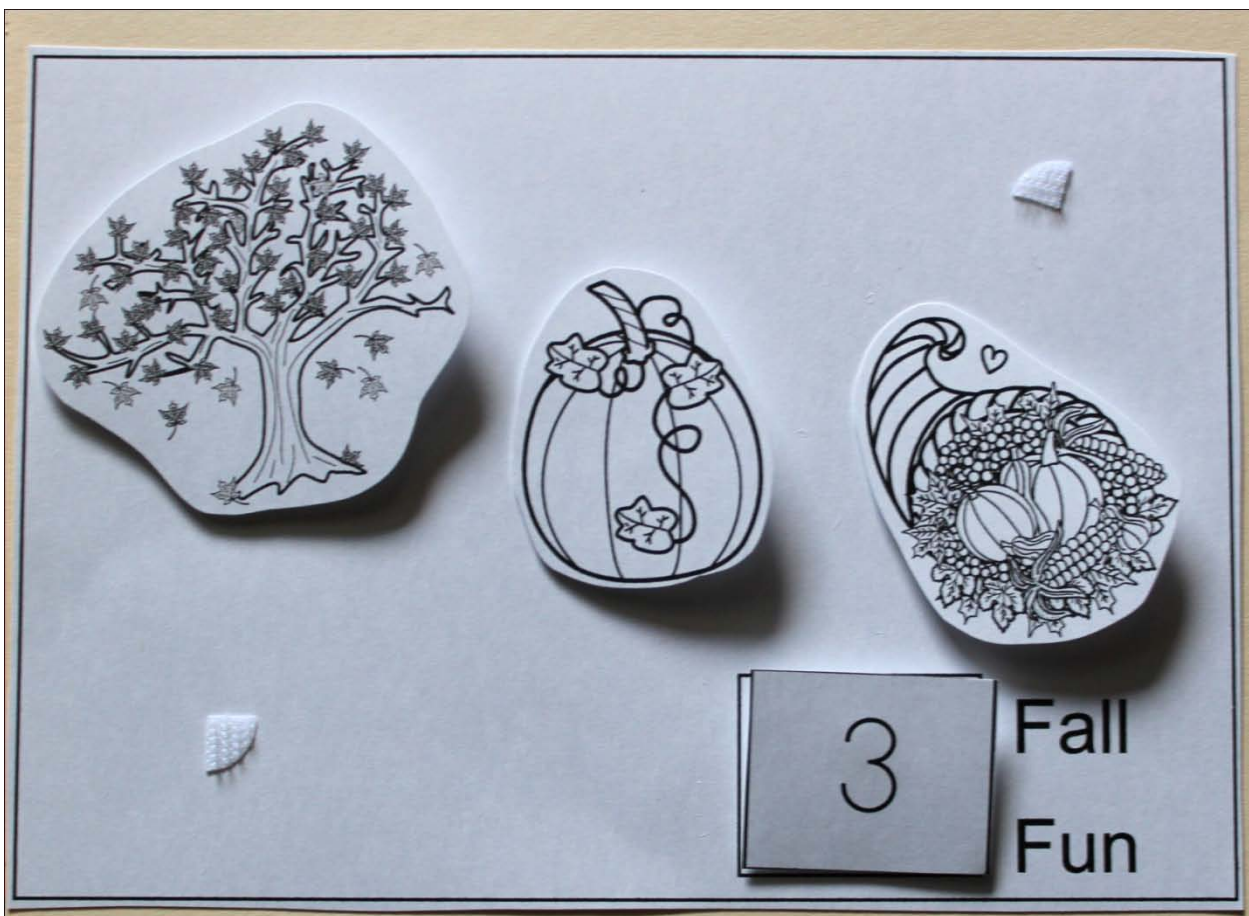
- Have children place a number card inside the number box.
- Have them tell you what the number is.
- Have children then place the correct number of fall pictures inside on the fall fun mat.
- Children can place this activity again and again by removing the fall pictures and numbers, and placing a new number inside the number box and again the correct number of fall pictures.

Rough velcro pieces on the fall fun mat.



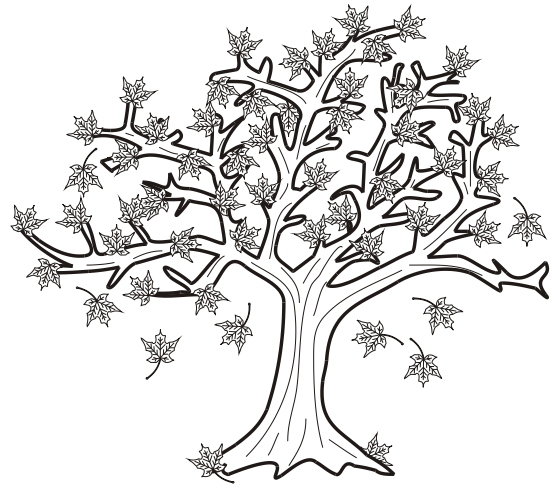
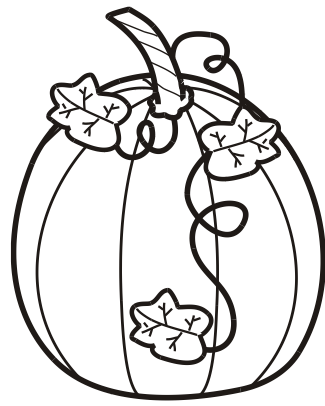

## Fall Items or Winter - Spring or Summer Items

- Print up on white card stock.
- Have children color - cut out.
- Fold the Fall Items or Winter - Spring or Summer Items sheet where indicated.
- Attach to lapbook using glue or double sided tape.
- Have children glue the fall items under the fall items cover, so when it is lifted, they can see what items are considered fall items.
- Have children glue the other items under winter - spring or summer items fold.

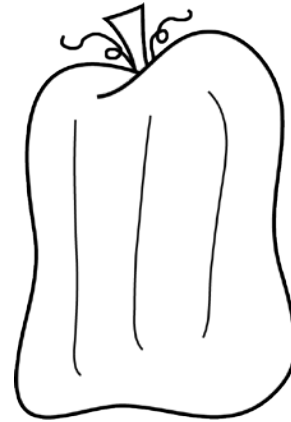
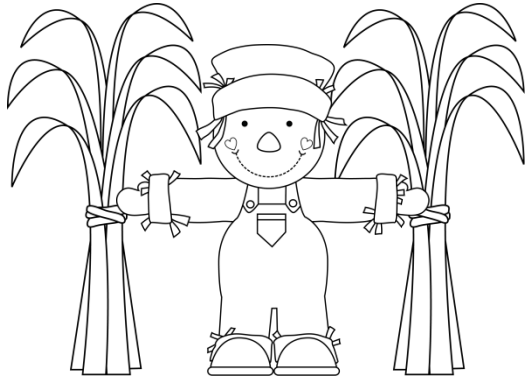
- Print up the following sheet onto regular paper.

- Use cards in your writing center. Let children practice writing the words on a dry eraser board or paper.



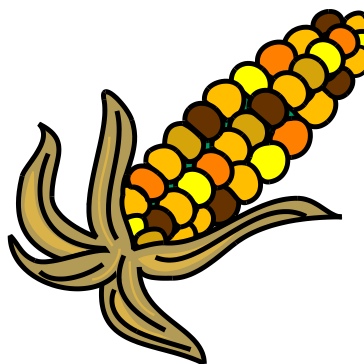
