Match the Pumpkins


Print on white card stock. Have children color and cut out. Attach to the inside of the lapbook.


Print on white card stock. Have children color. Trim to fit and attach to lapbook.


Happy Haunting Cover


- Print up the following sheet onto white card stock.

- Glue or tape the Happy Haunting banner to the top of the lapbook - cut banner so lapbook will open.
- Glue or tape the haunted house to the left side only of the lapbook. (This is so that when you open the lapbook, the monster will show.















Vocabulary Words and Picture Cards

Directions are on the cards but here are some additional ideas:


- Print up 2 copies, trim and use as a memory game.
- Use cards in your writing center. Let children practice writing the words on a dry eraser board or paper.


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
Vocabulary Words and Picture Cards

Laminate for durability. Use for matching, writing, spelling or oral language activities.
























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




















Match the Pumpkins

- Use the envelope to store the pumpkin pieces.




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










Spider and Number Storage

Book comes in 2 formats

- With dotted words

Print first 2 sheets back to back. Fold in ½. Print up next 2 pages back to back. Fold in ½ and place inside the cover.

Please note: Use the book format that works best with each child. Older children can practice writing the words without the dots. ©
