

# Mom Mother's Day Card



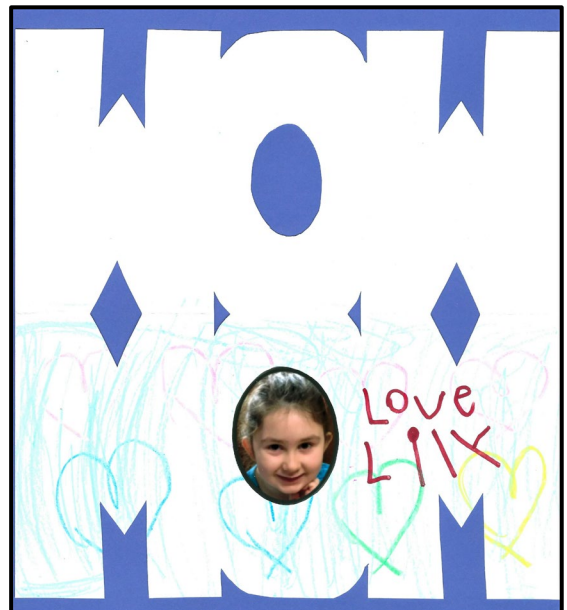
Supplies needed:

- White card stock
- Crayons or markers
- Scissors
- Glue or double-sided tape



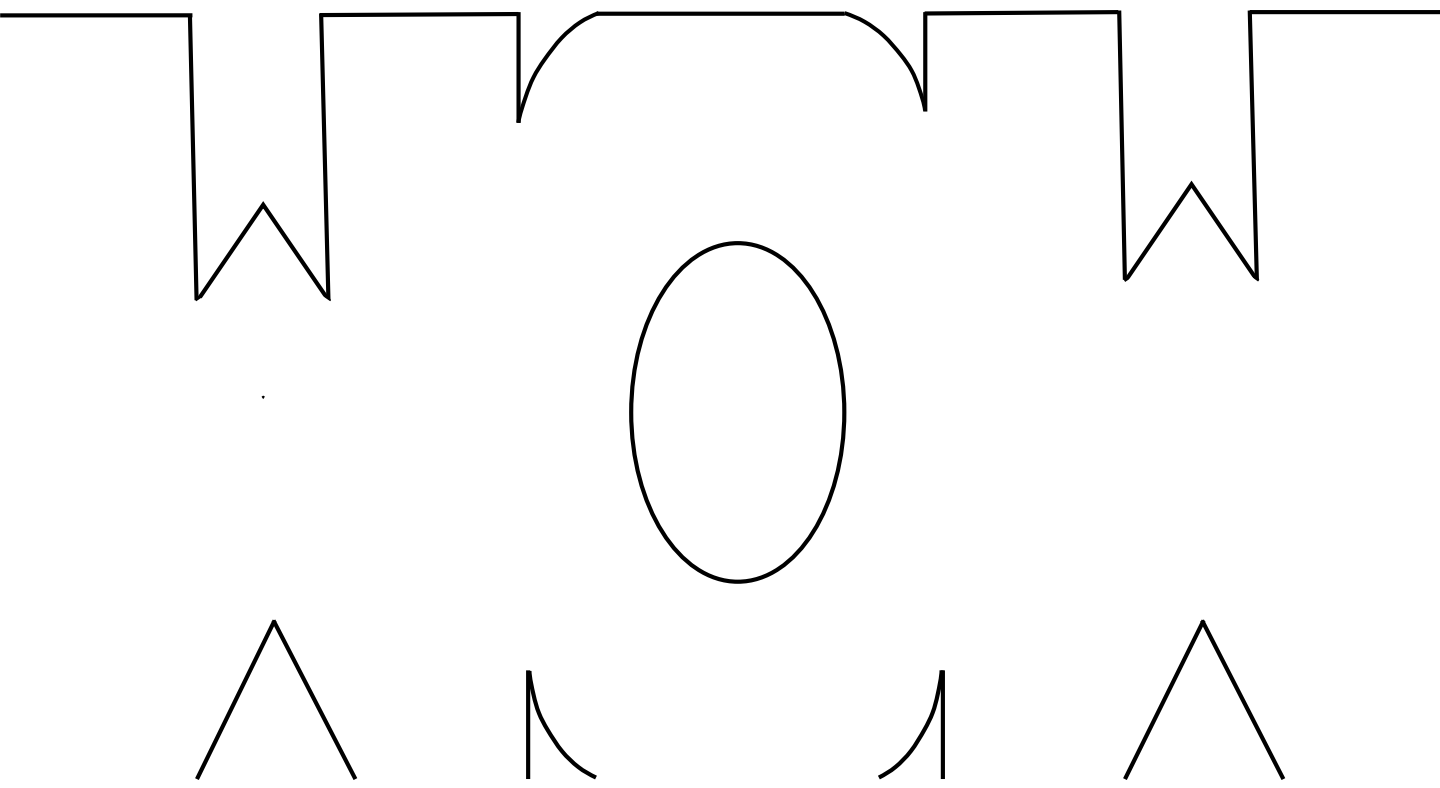
Directions:

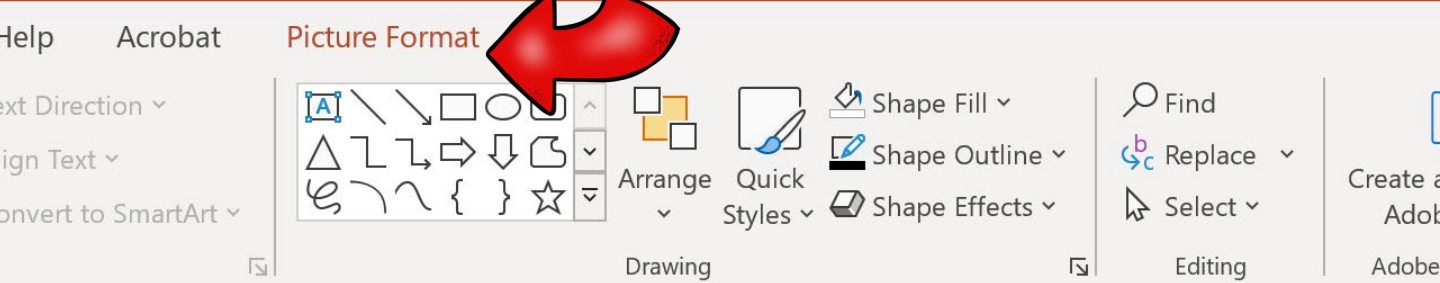
- Print up the mom template on white card stock. \*
- Fold the sheet in half and cut out on the lines to create the mom card.
- Have children color the front of the card and the inside with crayons or markers.
- See the next page for adding photo.



\* If you want to do this card for infants, print up on color cardstock, fold and cut out. Take a picture of the infant and add to the inside of the card with glue or double-sided tape. Directly under the oval..

Print - Fold paper in 1/2 - Cut out on lines



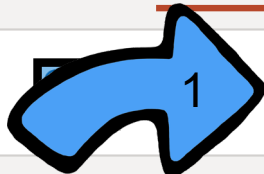


There is a separate PowerPoint sheet that has ovals the size of the hole on the mom card.

Take a head shot picture of child, crop and get it to the size you want.

Load it to the separate PowerPoint file to adjust the size of the photo. You can keep the picture square. If that is the case, just make sure the child's photo will fit inside the oval when closed

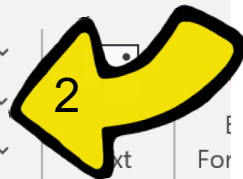
If you want to make the picture an oval, add picture, place behind an oval so that you adjust the correct size of the picture. Remove oval and then click on Picture Format. (Red arrow).

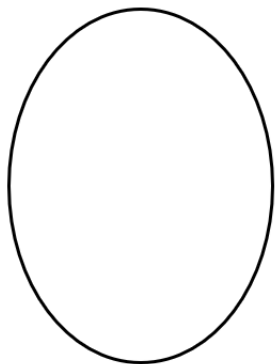

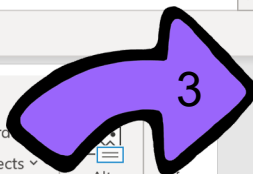
