




Spring Time Lap book

- Print up the cover sheet onto white card stock.
- Have children color and cut out.
- Add spring time label and picture to a piece of green card stock and trim the green card stock. (See picture below).
- Cut the sprint time label in half, and attach to both sides of the lap book, so that when the lap book is closed, the label connects.
- Add picture to the front of the lap book. (You will apply glue or double sided tape to only the left side of the orange card stock so the lap book opens.)




You have 2 options for a front cover. Sunshine helps plants to grow. Inside Plants also need rain.



Back of Lapbook

Storage for Spring is in the Air Book

- Make a pocket for book by using a piece of green card stock.
- Measure the width you want and cut it down.
- Using double sided tape on both sides and bottom of green card stock, attach to the bottom.
- Tape or glue It is Spring Time picture to the pocket.





Print up on white card stock









Glue or tape to the back of the lapbook. (On the pocket you make). Make a pocket out of card stock to store It is Spring Time book.

Parts of the Flower directions:

Print up Parts of the Flower picture on white card stock. Using double sided tape, add to lapbook. See pictures to see placement.

Print up flower cards on white card stock.


Cut out cards.


Place Velcro on the Parts of a Flower picture, in the squares – rough side.

Place the soft part of the Velcro on the back side of the cards.

Children can match the parts of a flower by placing the correct word card where it belongs. Words can also be used – writing on paper.


Flip Book Spring Has Sprung

- Make sure the pictures of the flipbook are placed in the correct order. (smallest to biggest)
- Place on the right upper side of the lapbook.





- Attach the pocket envelope to the inside of the lapbook. Right hand side.
- Have children use the cards to practice writing words or reading.





- During May the flowers will start to bloom.







Spring Counting


- Print up on regular copy paper.

- Attach to the inside of the Spring Time lap book using double-sided tape or glue.














Spring Items or Winter Items

- Print up on white card stock.
- Have children color cut out.
- Fold the Spring Items or Winter Items sheet where indicated.
- Attach to lapbook using glue or double sided tape.
- Have children glue the spring items under the spring items cover, so when it is lifted, they can see what items are considered spring items.
- Have children glue the other items under winter items fold.

- Without dotted words


Print first 2 sheets back to back. Fold in $\frac{1}{2}$.

Print up last 2 pages back to back. Fold in $\frac{1}{2}$ and place inside the cover.

Please note: Use the book format that works best with each child. Older children can practice writing the words without the dashes.


Staple if desired. (You will need a longer stapler in order to do this. Can be purchased at Office Max or other office supply store).
