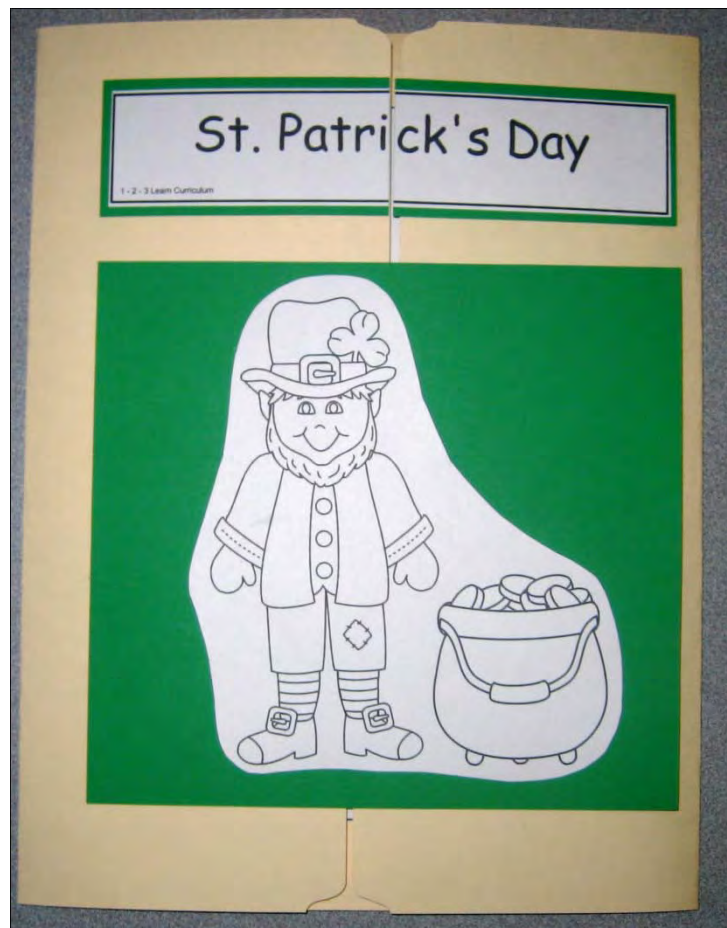

St. Patrick's Day Lapbook

- Print up the cover sheet onto white card stock.
- Have children color and cut out.
- Add St. Patrick's Day label and picture to a green piece of card stock and trim the green card stock. (See sample)
- Cut the St. Patrick's Day label in half, and attach to both sides of the lapbook, so that when the lapbook is closed, the label connects.
- Add picture to the front of the lapbook.

Back of Lapbook

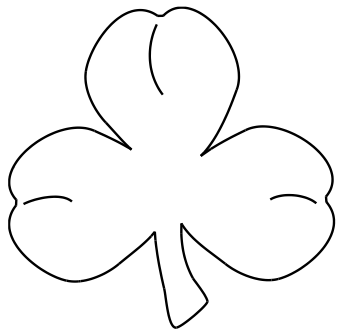
Storage for Happy St. Patrick's Day Book

- Tape or glue the shamrocks and Happy St. Patrick's Day banner to the back of the lapbook.

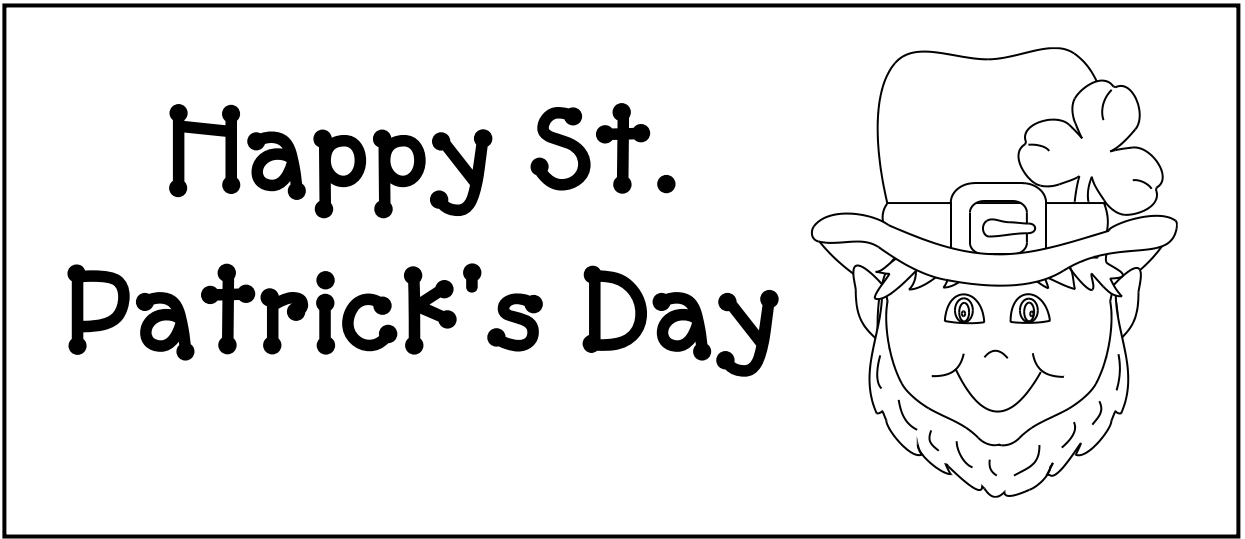

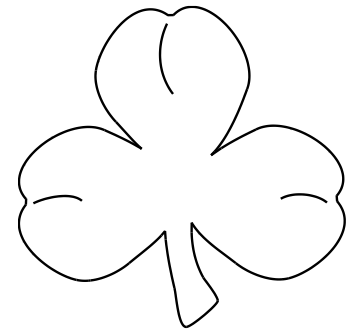
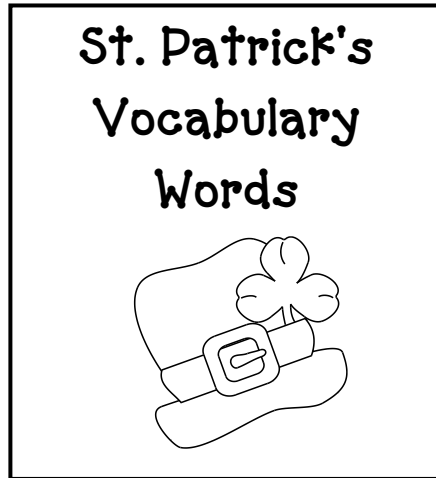
Print up on white card stock
