Thanksgiving Lapbook Cover

- Print up the following sheet onto white card stock.
- Have children color.
- Cut out the Thanksgiving banner and turkey.
- Cut out the feathers for the turkey. (Sample shows the feathers printed on green, yellow and red card stock).
- Glue the feathers onto the back of the turkey.
- Glue or tape the Thanksgiving banner to the top of the lapbook - cut banner so the lapbook will open.
- Glue or tape the turkey to a piece of card stock. Trim the card stock.
- Glue or tape the finished turkey to the left side only of the lapbook. (This is so that when you open the lapbook, the turkey saying Eat Beef! will show.

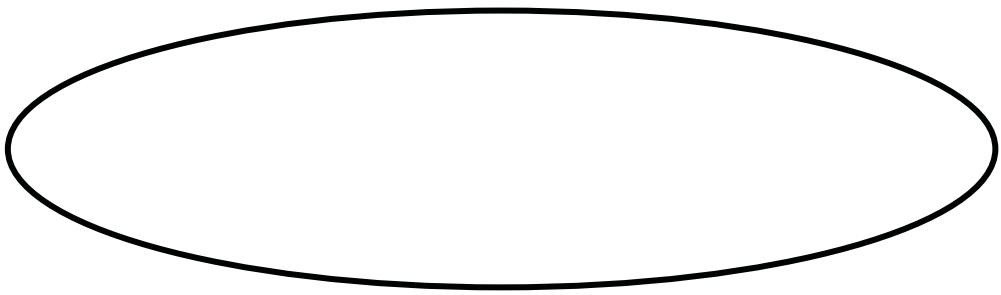
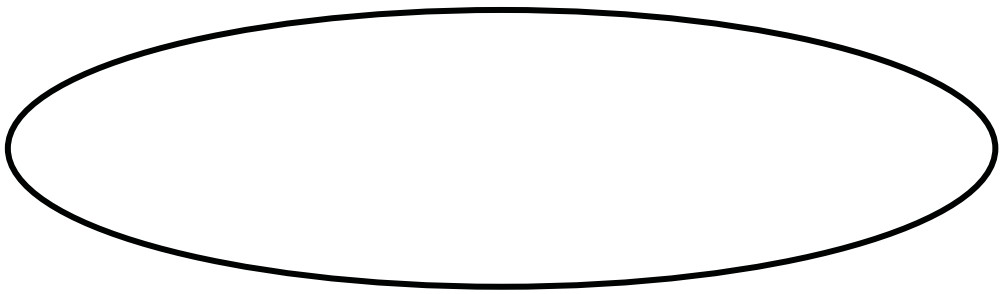
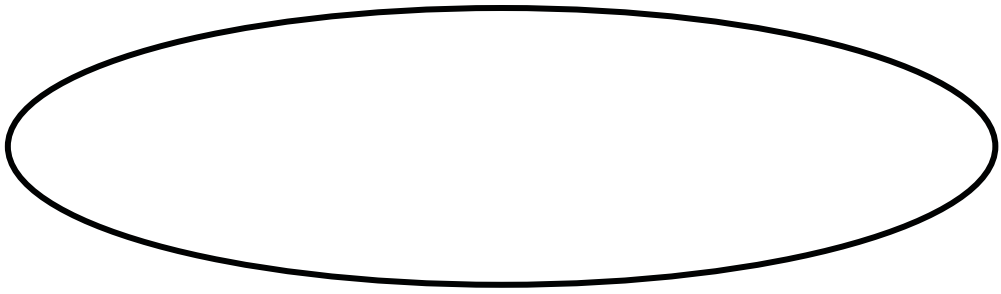
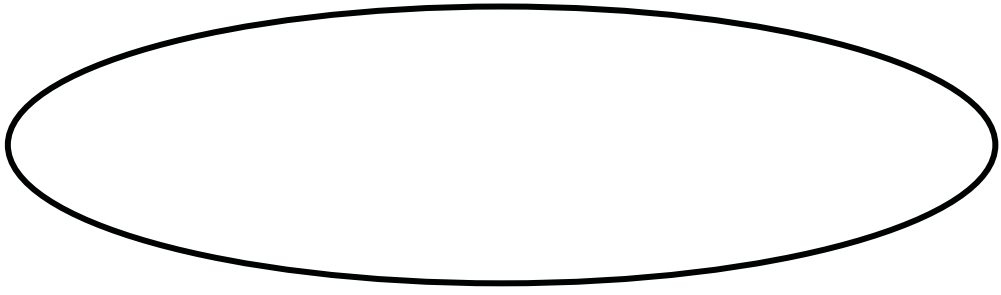
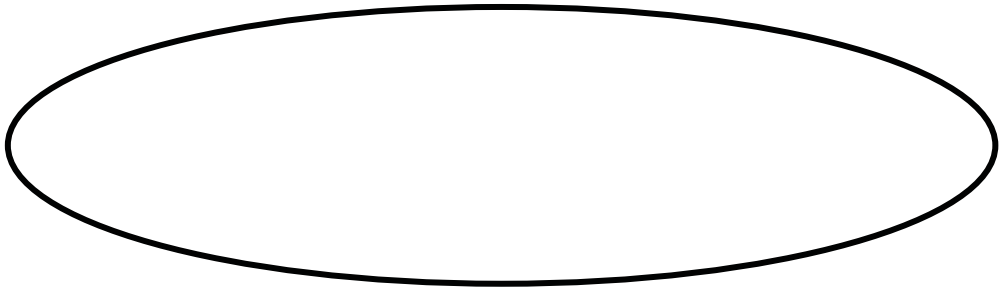

Turkey Feathers

- Print up on white card stock.
- Color the feathers.
- Cut out feathers.
- Glue to the back of the turkey.
- If desired, once the feathers are glued to the turkey, children can write on the feathers what they are thankful for. (family, friends, food, etc).
- Glue or tape the turkey to the front of the file folder.
- Cut down the middle on the file folder so that the file folder will open. When closed, it will show the picture of the turkey.

- Place on the right upper side of the lapbook.

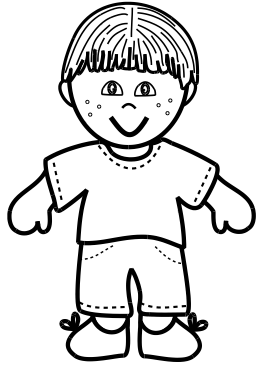

Please Note: There are 2 pages for the flip book. Print up the boy page for boys to color and the girl page for girls to color.

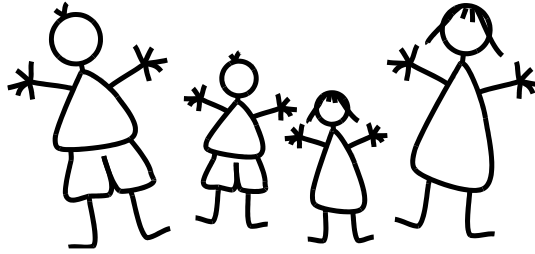
(There is a boy on the cover sheet of the flipbook and a girl on the cover sheet).

- Use cards in your writing center. Let children practice writing the words on a dry eraser board or paper.

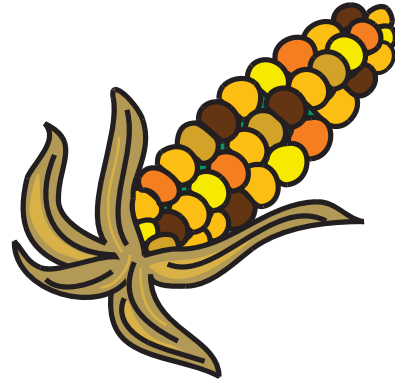

The First Thanksgiving



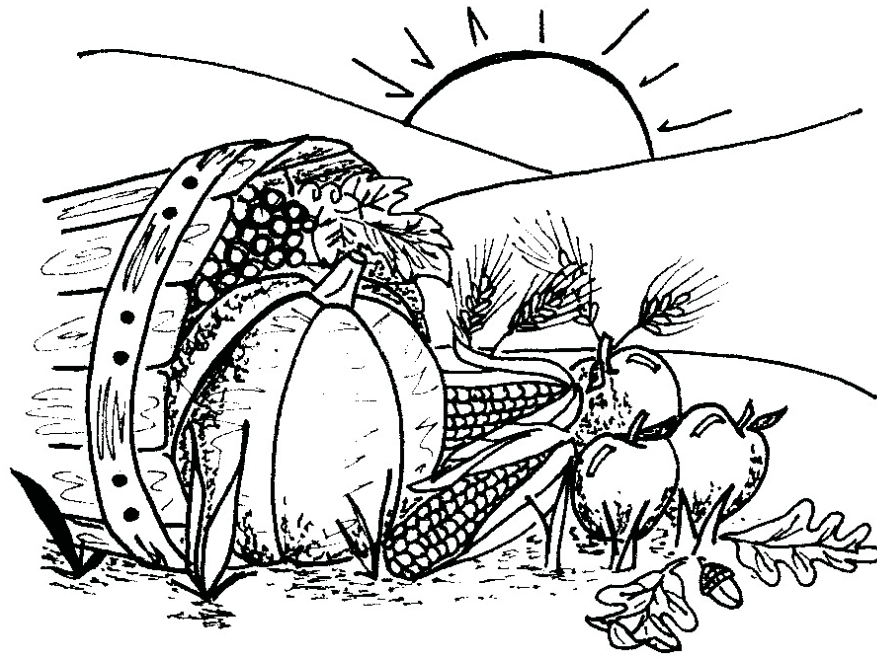
In the year 1620, the Pilgrims sailed from England to look for the New World on a ship called the Mayflower. Their voyage took 65 days.



The Pilgrims landed near Plymouth Rock and started to build homes. The first winter there wasn't enough food for everyone, so many people died.



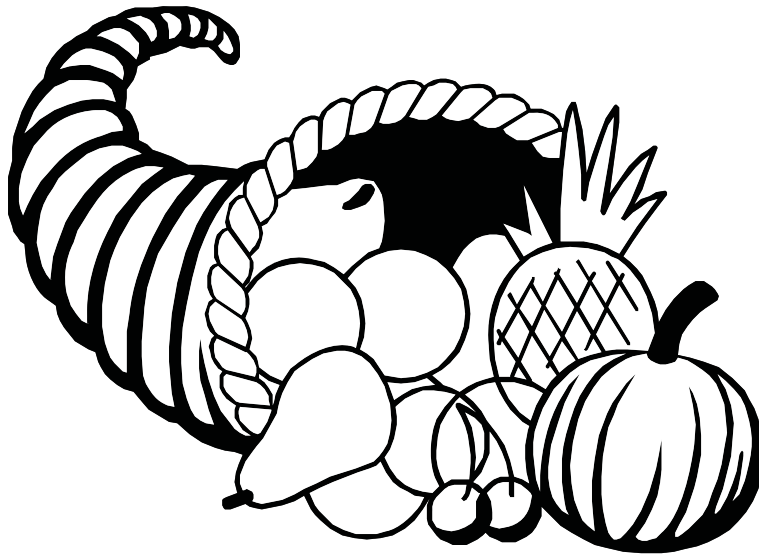
In the spring of 1621, The Pilgrims became friends with the Wampanoag tribe of Native Americans.



The Wampanoag helped the Pilgrims learn how to hunt better and how to plant crops, including corn.



The fall harvest was so good in 1621 and the Pilgrims were so thankful that they invited their native American Friends to a feast.



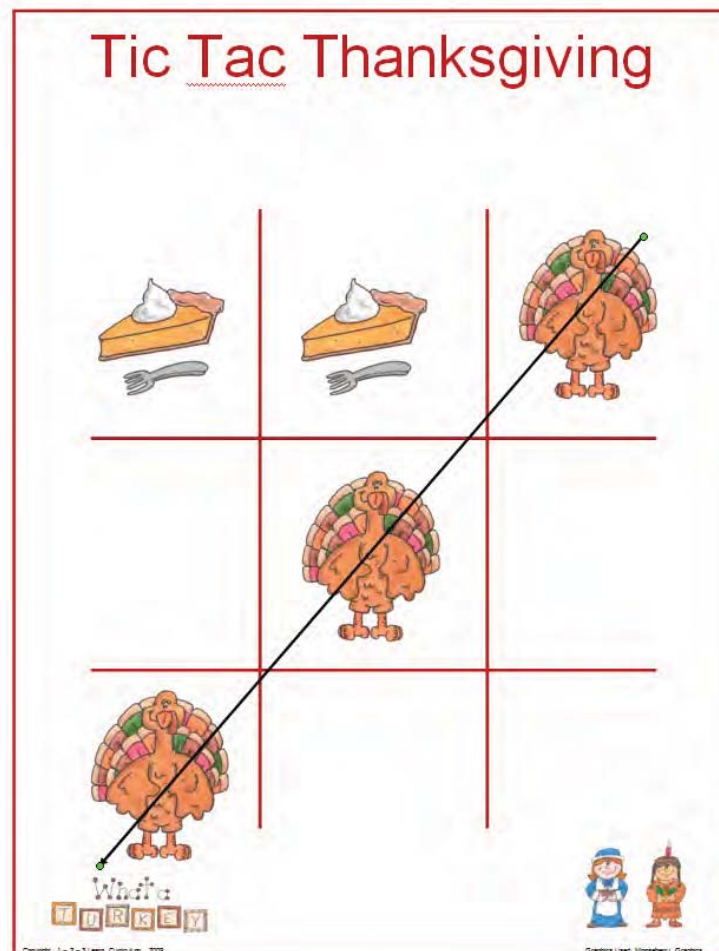
The first Thanksgiving feast lasted for 3 days. Thanksgiving is celebrated on the fourth Thursday of November as a national holiday. On Thanksgiving we remember the Pilgrims and the Indians who helped them.



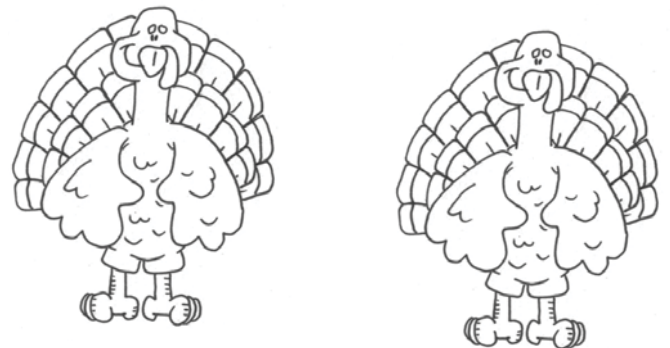
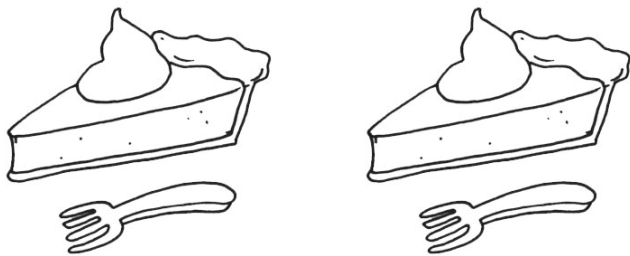
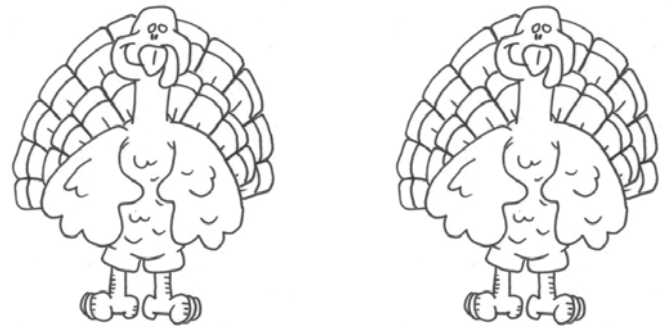
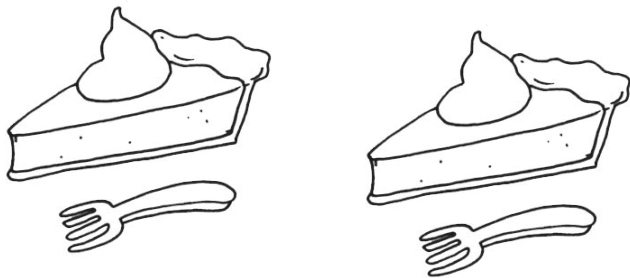
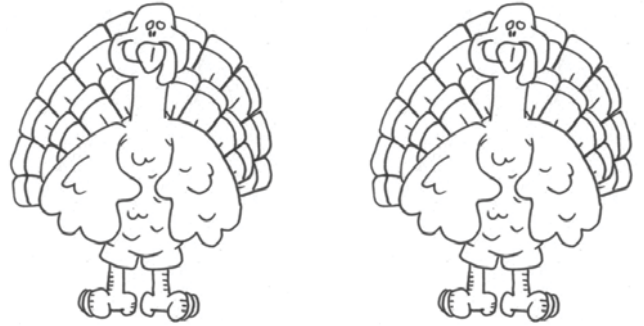
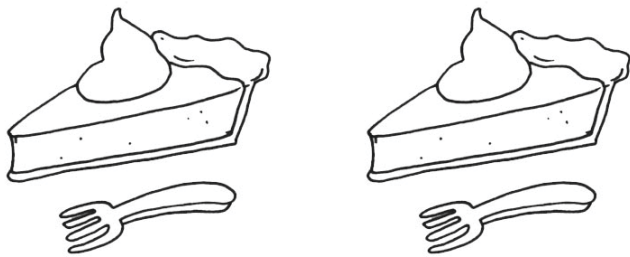
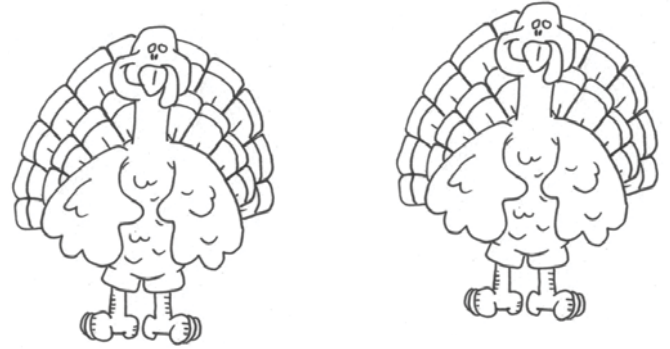
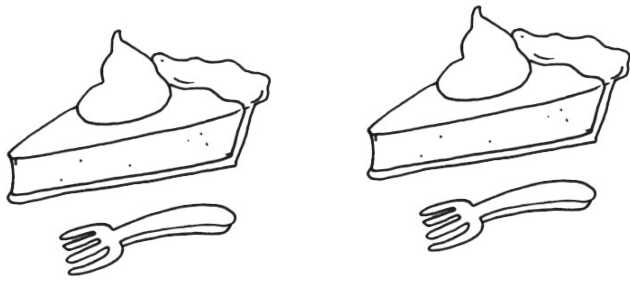
