
# Build a Dog










## D is for Dog

- Googly eyes (optional)


#### Directions:

- Print up D is for Dog template and sheet on white card stock.
- Have children color and cut out.
- Glue pieces together on the D is for Dog sheet.

#### Steps:

- Glue tail to the back left hand side of the D.
- 2. Glue the D to the D is for Dog template.
- Glue on 2 legs on the lower part of the D, ears to the top and nose the upper part of the D. See picture for placement.
- 4. Have children draw 2 eyes or attach googly eyes.

Hang up and enjoy during your pets theme.
