

Pets Cap Counting Activity Cards

Pets Cap Counting Activity Cards



This activity was designed using the caps off Squeezable – Applesauce and Shine Organics pouches. You can also use milk covers, Poms Poms or play dough rolled up into balls.

Supplies needed:

- Number format. 1 20.
- Caps off of squeezable containers, gallon milk covers or other items for counting. Keep in mind the age of your children and choking hazards.
- Laminating sheets.
- Bowl for caps or other counting supplies.


Directions:


- After printing up the templates you are going to use, laminate cards.
- Have children sit at table with a bowl or basket of the covers you are going to use.
- Start with the number 1. Ask child what the number is and help them if needed. Count with them the number of caps you want to put on the card.
- You can also work in colors by asking child what color they would like to use or ask them to pick a certain color to place on the card.
- You can do this as a group or one on one as a center activity.


This pets counting caps activity cards include a blue circle for each number on the cards.


Number 1 = 1 circle, number 2 = 2 circles and so on. Use this template if you have younger children so they have a visual of the number of caps to put on each card.





























































This pets counting caps activity cards include a colored outline circle for each number on the cards.




Count with them as they do this activity to reinforce number counting.























































This pets counting caps activity cards include a black outline circle for each number on the cards.
