This will give you a lower quality page but will save on ink.



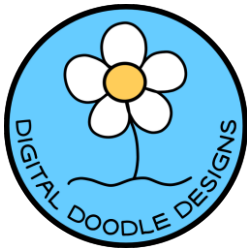

Crayons and markers are the first thought, but use your imagination.

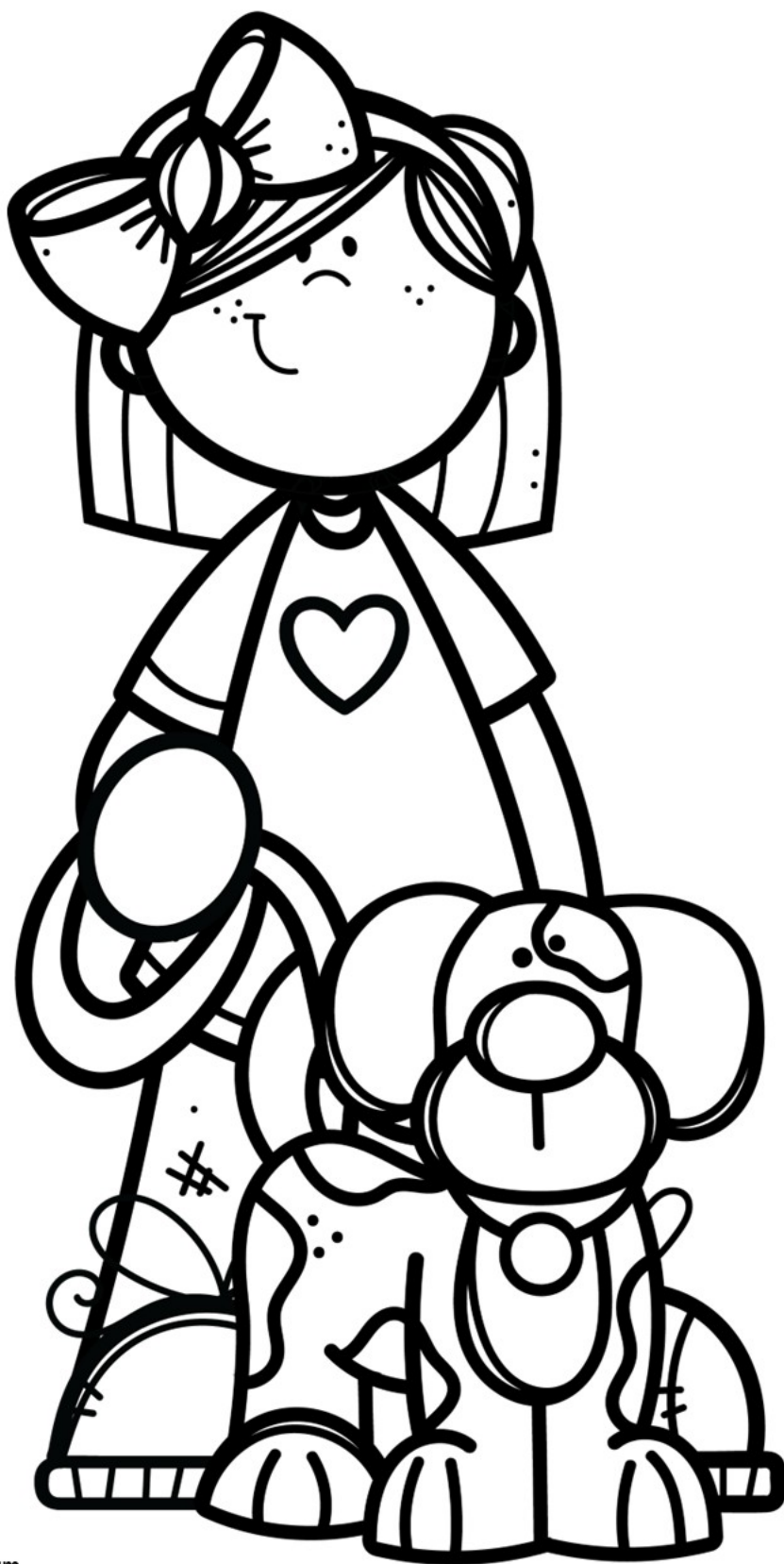
Print up some of the worksheets on white card stock and let the children paint them.

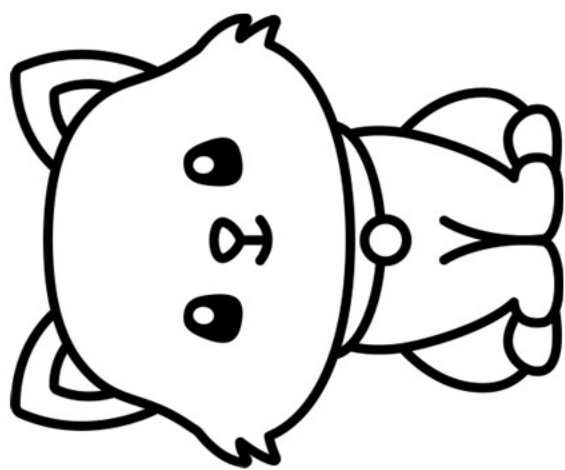
Place the back-cover 1st, and all the number cards in order. Place the pictures of the pet pictures in random order. Place the cover on top.

You can either bind the book or put rings on the top of the page to keep the book together.

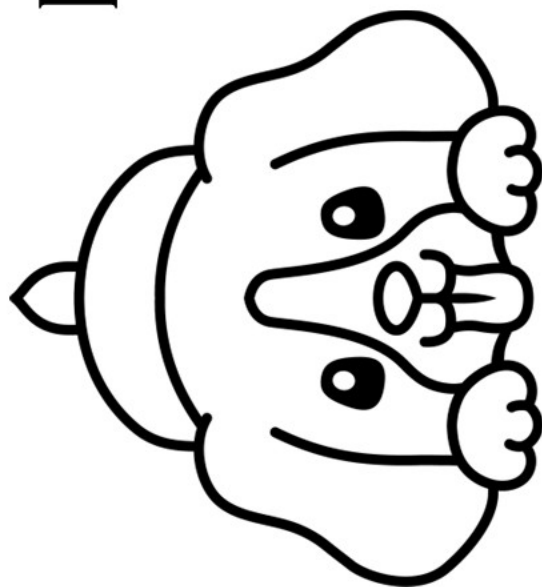
