


Google Slides can be viewed on various platforms, including the web browser, Google Drive, and the Google Slides app. Here are the different ways to view Google Slides presentations:


**Web Browser**: Access Google Slides by visiting the website (slides.google.com) and signing in with your Google account. You can create, edit, or view presentations directly from the web browser.

These platforms provide a convenient way to view and manage your Google Slides presentations, whether you're at home, on the go, or collaborating with others.






## Number Writing and Counting

Follow the directions below.

1. Click on picture to access the Number Writing and Counting File.



Click on view. There will be a dropdown bar. Click on slide show.

- A new window will open up with a full screen of the file. (To exit you will click on the Esc button – upper left-hand corner).
- 4. The number 0 will stay on the screen until child either clicks on the screen or if using a computer hit the space bar).
- Have a piece of paper and pencil or marker for child to practice writing the number on the screen. Go onto the next number.
